Austria and the "Boycott."

Reserves to be Kept Under Arms.

Dec. 1.—Heater at Constantinople states that the Austrian Ambassador is renewing his protest and has declared that Austria cannot tolerate a boycott.

The Grand Vizier is doing every thing possible and unobtrusively to the Custon Houses.

At Vienna it is stated that Government has decided to retain 110,000 of the so-called supplementary reserves whose term is on the point of expiring.

Vienna and Servia

Alleged Panic of Troops.

Nov. 30.—Assurances given by the Turkish General Staff and the Austrian Ambassador at Belgrade, who is en route to Constantinople, have restored optimism at Vienna.

The report of the Austrian press is absolutely devoid of Vienna and is said to be based solely on the removal of the Austrian 60,000 inland owing to a possible attack by the Montenegrins.

At Belgrade official reports are published from letters that 25,000 Austrian troops on the Montenegrin frontier, believing themselves cut off, have been perishing and are precipitately abandoning a portion of their munitions and artillery. Two generals have been captured in consequence.

Montenegro has handed the representatives of the Powers at Berlin a memorandum demanding the cession of Spigga from Austria.

Severe Riots.

Dec. 2.—At Czecho and Prague a two days riotous Pro-Servian and Anti-Austrian demonstrations took place, the gendarmes made sword bayonet charges and many troops and many gendarmes were injured.

Accident during Fetes in Vienna.

Rioting Still Continues.

Dec. 3.—A noticeably improvement has taken place in the Austro-Austrian relations which it is believed is due to the influence of the Emperor Francis Joseph.

The Austrian Ambassador at Constantinople, but there are rumours at Buda Pest and Belgrade that transports have been ordered to be in readiness at Ragusa, causing uneasiness.

Important Agreement Signed.

Dec. 2.—Mr. Root and Takahira have signed an agreement.

Satisfactory Negotiations.

Dec. 1.—The Turco Bulgarian negotiations are practically concluded and the Bulgarians are returning to Sofia to report to Government.

The Polar Expedition.

Dec. 2.—The "Nautilus" has sailed from Christ Church, Feb. 18. The "Nautilus" has been refitted and takes a year's provisions.

Lord Methuen in Johannesburg.

Dec. 2.—Lord Methuen at a banquet in Johannesburg explained that his mission as mentioned on 23rd October was not in view of the permanent withdrawal of the regular troops, but to enable the Empire to rely on very small force available to itself. Half per cent elsewhere it is feared.

Another Serious Accident in a Colmine.

Dec. 2.—At Lithgow an explosion in a colmine at Marrianna was followed by a fire and it is feared that 200 have been entombed and suffocated.

Nine Hundred People Lost.

Dec. 1.—Two hundred and fifty of the miners entombed in the Marrianna mine are regarded as hopeless.

Admiral Scott's Tour.

Dec. 2.—Admiral Scott's squadron has arrived at Kio and arrangements are being made for great festivities.

The Joint Stock Trust.

Dec. 2.—Bottomley and three others have been charged with fraud at the Joint Stock Trust and Finance Company which was wound up in 1904.

Ayov is prosecuting said. 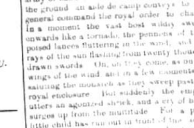

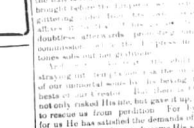

Dec. 4.—The German Colonial Office is considering a plan to irrigate German East Africa by a canal through the Vembere steppes from Lake Victoria Nyanza.

Dec. 5.—General Ismail Mahir-pasha, the special delegate to Somalia, last May was regarded as a spy of the old regime and assassinated on Thursday night at Constantinople by an officer.
The assassin escaped.

An Avalanche.
Dec. 5.—An avalanche has overwhelmed the village of Pra Venetia killing 31.

A Fairly Sound Scheme for the Reform of the House of Lords.
Dec. 5.—The report of the Lords Committee on the Reform of the House of Lords recommends that the House of Lords should be called Lords of Parliament, a Peerage alone not carrying with it such a right. Hereditary Peers to elect 200 representatives for the duration of each Parliament. The Bishops to be represented by Archbishops of whom self-governing colonies by nominees from their respective Governments.

A French Admiral tells Official Secrets.
Dec. 5.—Clemenceau summoned to Paris and severely reprimanded Admiral Germinet, the Commander of the Mediterranean Squadron and an eminent Naval Authority for a breach of discipline in granting an interview in which he declared that the armament of the fleet was 50% below requirements. It is expected that he will be severely dealt with.

Holland and Venezuela.
Dec. 5.—Dutch warships yesterday made a demonstration off Puerto Cabello, Lagunaira and Maracaibo and a blockade is expected.

World's News by Cable.

How the British Fleet can be Evaded.

Dec. 6.—Admiral Finnis speaking at Dover said that during the late manoeuvres he conveyed a force representing 70,000 men to the Scottish Coast and did not sight the British Fleet owing to fog.

Mr. McKenna Denies all Statements Attributed to Admiral Finnis.

Dec. 8.—Mr. McKenna has announced that with regard to the statement attributed to Admiral Finnis on the 3rd Inst. he had no command during the late manoeuvres, no such incident occurred as was related, nor anything affording the slightest foundation for such a statement.

Admiral Finnis explains that his works were misinterpreted, exaggerated and incorrect. Mr. McKenna is taking further steps to discover the precise language used.

A Climax Reached on the Education Bill.

Dec. 7.—Fifteen after sympathizing with Serbia and Montenegro whom however, he was only able to help diplomatically, strongly criticized Austria's procedure and advised Turkey and the Balkan States to cease fractious and unite in the defence of their integrity.

Two liners have sailed from Fiume, under sealed orders, it is believed in Vienna they are going to Cattaro.

A Vote of Confidence.

The Italian Chamber passed a vote of confidence in the Government by 307 to 140.

Dec. 7.—At Rome, it is officially announced, that Italian troops repulsed an attack of 2,000 Dervishes at Calalio, in Somaliland, with considerable loss.

Forty eight dead were picked up and the Italians were unscathed.

A New Governor.

Dec. 9.—Admiral Bosanquet has been appointed Governor of South Australia.

The Death Penalty in France.

Dec. 9.—After a protracted debate, the French Chamber has decided to maintain the death penalty by a 330 to 301 vote.

Great Haul for the Exchequer.

Dec. 9.—The Estate of the late Henry Barnato, brother of Barney Barnato, exceeds 5 millions sterling.

Hop Dumping to Cease.

Dec. 9.—Mr. Lloyd George has introduced a bill for labelling foreign hops and prohibiting chemical substitutes.

There was practically no opposition.

The King Better.

Dec. 9.—The King is much better and has gone to Brighton to visit the Sassoons.

The Chattering of Admirals Condemned.

Dec. 10.—The case of Admiral Hermet has been lively debated in the French Chamber, the Government being accused of harshness.

Picard stated that strong action was necessary in the interests of discipline and Clemencaux represented as a certain enforcement of national character too much anxiety to dodge responsibility and said that the Navy cannot be restrained by the chattering of Admirals. The Chamber voted confidence in the Government's ability to rehabilitate the Navy by 355 to 112.

World's News by Cable.

Stringent Measures to Deal with Anarchism.

Arrest of Leaders.

Dec. 15.—At Calcutta, the Viceroy's Council has passed a Bill to provide for a speedy and more summary trial for Anarchists and seditious Nationalists, also a Bill of Dangerous Societies Bill applicable to Lower Bengal and Assam with power to extend to other provinces. The native members warmly supported the Bills.

Arrests have been made under the new act of Kumaratni, a prominent Nationalist leader in Calcutta, and Kumaradit, a Nationalist leader in Eastern Bengal who has intensely excited the natives.

Dec. 16.—Seven more leading wealthy Nationalists have been arrested in Calcutta. Arrests and searches have revealed a conspiracy more serious and extensive than believed.

Dec. 17.—Arrests continue to be made in many districts of Bengal.

Going to the Country on the House of Lords Question.

Dec. 14.—Mr. Asquith speaking at the National Liberal Club said that the veto of the House of Lords must be treated as the dominating issue of politics, but it was absurd for the Lords to presume to dictate the time for dissolution, the certain in which would choose its own time.

An Investiture.

Dec. 15.—The King returned to London yesterday to hold an investiture. The King held the investiture and returns to Brighton to-day.

Holland Makes a Move.

Dec. 15.—A Dutch Cruiser has seized a Venezuelan coast-guardship outside Puerto Cabello and sent the crew ashore and the vessel to Curaçao.

Dec. 16.—Great excitement exists at Caracas, demonstrations are taking place on the part of Castro supporters and in conflicts with their opponents several have been killed and wounded.

The Dutch have captured the small Venezuelan gunboat "Mayo."

The 8 Hours Bill in the Lords

Dec. 16.—The House of Commons have passed the 8 Hours Bill a third time by 204 to 89 votes.

Dec. 17.—The House of Lords read a second time the Miners' 8 Hours Bill, but Lord Lansdowne intimated that it will be seriously amended.

Annexation.

Dec. 15.—The Chamber has passed a Bill declaring that the Anjouan, Mohoré Islands and Grand Comoro be French Colonies.

Elephant Slaughter and the Lado Enclave.

Dec. 15.—The Imperial Government has instructed Sir Eton Greed to recommend to the Sudan Authorities that all possible steps be taken to prevent the destruction of elephants in the Lado Enclave if the reports made regarding their wholesale slaughter can be verified.

Sedition on a Cruiser.

Dec. 15.—All leave has been stopped on the Cruiser Amethyst at Portsmouth owing to some gunfire having been thrown overboard.

Gamble to go to Turkey.

Dec. 15.—Britain lends Turkey Rear Admiral Douglas Gemble to reorganise her Navy.

More Complications in Morocco.

Dec. 17.—Fifty Foreign legionaries and German recruits held up and turned back a train containing General Vigy in Southern Algeria. There was no violence, but they fled towards Morocco. Ultimately 49 were captured.

Roosevelt Denounces Malignant Writing.

Dec. 17.—President Roosevelt in a special message to Congress denounces in the most vehement terms allegations of corruption in the acquisition of the Panama Canal as infamous libels upon the individual officials concerned and Government.

The real offender is Pulitzer, the Editor of the "World" and it therefore the High National Duty to bring to justice this wanton, wicked slander of the American people.

Afraid of the Foo Foo Traders.

Dec. 17.—The Hops Bill has been dropped owing to the opposition of the extreme Free Traders.

Aerial Navigation.

Dec. 17.—The French Government is summoning an International Conference to consider a code of laws for aerial navigation.

CHRISTMAS TOYS THAT ARE TALKED ABOUT.

SOME QUAINT CHRISTMAS PRESENTS.

A very pretty fashion has become prevalent among French artists, whose minds and genius are as it is well known, most versatile. Instead of confining all their abilities to the picture or caricatures which have rendered their names famous, they are now indulging in the pastime of creating "marionettes," puppets or toys. Most boys being made by uneducated workmen, with no artistic qualifications, are more nothing to put into the hands of children to while away their abundant leisure. But the boys who I am going to tell my readers about are very different. Created by three artists of world-wide fame they are almost unexcelled in their art. —say, Georges Hertrand, whose the life of a lion. She is passionately fond of the little



medium of classical line, he has stolen upon more the fire of the gods from the altars of Olympus to bestow not only life but a soul, on what he calls his "Animated Dolls," and give them their French names, his exquisite animation.

Georges Hertrand is one of the greatest French historical painters of the age. It seems strange that an artist such as he, who paints huge canvases of artistic value, can give so much time and thought to mere puppets. He has told me how the first idea on this subject originated in his brain. He was painting a large battle-piece, and needed a horse in a special attitude. It was not convenient to introduce a horse into the studio, so he set to work and made a small mould in wood, which served his purpose admirably.

This toy horse pleased the artist so much that he made up his mind to create a set of puppets which would be so perfect in their mechanism as to be the exact prototype of the human anatomy. I was fortunate enough to see these animated dolls of Georges Hertrand at a private rehearsal he gave in his own studio in Versailles, before the puppets made their public "debut" on the Paris

stage. No pen can fully describe the charm of those little men and women, who walk, sing, dance, smile, and how to the audience in a most life-like manner. They are wonderful creations and seem to breathe even as they walk to and fro on the stage, even as if they were one of the most skilful of the "Chef d'Orchestre" draws, specially for me by Georges Hertrand himself.

Another celebrated painter who has a remarkable collection of marionettes is Madame Jeanne Forain, whose husband's famous drawings are so well known in France. Madame Forain is a portrait painter, whose special genius lies in depicting child-like faces. She is passionately fond of the little
