**SCALE INSECTS.**

The scale insects form a large group embracing some 5000 species of Coccoidea.

The popular name scale insects, appropriately describes their shape and appearance.

The shape is usually flat, but may be in the form of a ball or a dome, or even a flat oval.

The female insects are usually sharply differentiated in the adult stage. The female retains more or less the flat oval shape and appearance.

The male, on the other hand, is provided with a pair of legs and a pair of eyes, but has no feeding apparatus.

The reproductive powers of scale insects are considerable. The number of young produced from each female varies from a few to a large number of species producing the vast numbers of a scale.

The life cycle is usually short, and with a minimum of 2 or 3 generations in the year.

With their facilities the insects multiply rapidly into many thousands.

It is easy to imagine, therefore, that the cumulative effect of their work may lead to rapid overhauling and even death.

**Effect of Green Scale on the Tree.**

The scale attaches itself directly on the veins on either surface of the leaf.

This attachment is apparently for the purpose of allowing it to draw the food material from the tree.

The plant is thereby weakened, and the leaves wither and fall.

The result of the scale on the tree is to reduce the amount of food material available to the tree.

How far these various effects are caused depends largely on the amount of scale on the tree, and the position of the scale on the tree.

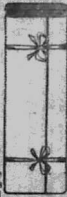
