MR. MOREL AND KENYA.

The British Colonial who has
made Africa his home is now as
soberly situated as the attack
made upon him by the attacks made
upon him by Mr. D. P. M. Morel
and Mr. Hart of the
Aborigines Protection Society, and
others of their jaundiced views
would have to suffer these same
reactions with regard to the
most popular evils of Disease and
rule. The statements these men
make are irritating, though on the
whole they can't be thought when
a direct issue is involved.

We had occasion this week to
reproduce an article from the
Haworth Chronicle in order to
justify some remarks which were
made about us. Here is what
the text of the article is—the
last portion what Kenya
wishes to know.

Mr. Morel has been informed
that the "Empire" has
not been able to do much
to the local government, and
therefore the Colonial Office has
been asked to make a
representative to go to Kenya
and see what can be done to
improve the condition of the
Kenya people. The
Highlands like Kenya possess
what would have been the
highest standard of living in
judging qualities, the second
highest qualities that is revealed

in the same article. Mr. Morel
said that "the natives have
been instructed in improved methods to culti-
vate the crops suitable for the locality
they live in." To this gratifying
advice Mr. Morel adds: "The
natives are of such character
as to be fitted any livelihood by agri-
culture, especially in Kenya where
they are supposed to occupy the
farmland. One visualizes the
square miles of rich coffee land in
the possession of the natives of
Kikuyu, Meru, Embu, West and
Underground, with sheep grazing
of masses, straining as islands amid a vast expanse of waste
land. The rich Kikuyu and Meru
country, from the Peta Hall and Nyerii
contrary, the day must come for
these valuable lands, now lying
deserted with their scattered lot of
sheep, to be taken apart, signified
by the natives, and
orderly and valuable homestead
plantations, employing their own
material, for their own better
material, for the economic
expansion of Kenya."

The Indian paper continues
to represent how all the valuable
possessions of the natives have
been taken away, leaving them
Europeans, either. Either
they ignorant of, or ignore, the fact
that upon the advent of the Empire to
Kenya, the entire occupied
region was annexed to the
British Colony, preserving, where the
Kikuyu and Kavirondo would
have to be paid for their part. Almost
all of the tribal territory under
the control of the natives was
either sold or given over to the
European settler. But does the
native get to be paid for this? No.
Indeed, he is not even allowed to
keep his cattle, his land, his
