**VETERINARY CONFERENCE CONTINUED.**  
IMPORTANT DEBATE AND CONCLUSIONS UPON PLEURO-PNEUMONIA.

Results in Wide Fields of Experiment. Resolution Calls for Official Co-operation as a Necessity.

Subsequent to the opening of the debate on bovine pleuro-pneumonia, by Mr. J. Walker, Kenya's chief Research Officer, the Conference discussed a very exhaustive debate on the personal experiences in fields of experiment, some to conclusions which were embodied in a resolution. The discussion was reviewed as follows:

Mr. J. Walker (Veterinary Research Officer, Kenya Colony) was pleased to have the opportunity of opening the debate on bovine pleuro-pneumonia, and I propose with your permission to deal now with the subject which has been carried out in connection therewith at the Kiboko Laboratory during the course of the last two or three years.

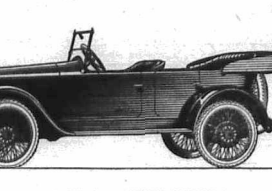

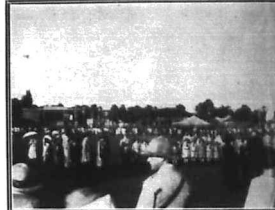

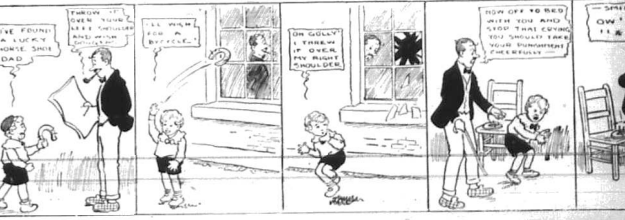

# EAST COAST FEVER.

## UNION POLICY FOR DEALING WITH THIS SCOURGE.

### An Interesting History.

#### DIPPING AND HAND DRESSING SUPERVISED.

Owing to pressure on space it is only possible to give the report on this important subject in instalments. Below is the opening portion of the address by Mr. W. M. Power (Chief Veterinary Officer, Natal) who opened the debate on the subject of East Coast Fever in the Union of South Africa for the eradication and control of this disease will be of interest to many in Kenya.

This important debate was opened by Mr. W. M. Power, Chief Veterinary Officer, Natal, who said: "Mr. Chairman and gentlemen—I am attempting to deal with East Coast fever. I do not refer to the disease in East African territories as I think it is preferable that the delegates from those areas should explain the position in regard to the disease and the steps, if any, that have been taken to deal with it."

I shall, however, refer to the Southern Provinces, viz., the Transvaal, Basutoland, and Bechuanaland, as Dr. Wilson and I were asked to represent those territories, but unfortunately that was not possible to obtain information as to what the disease in those areas is doing on this subject.

So far as the Union is concerned, East Coast fever exists in the Transvaal, Natal, the Transkei, and the Cape Provinces. In the Cape Colony has been divided into two areas for veterinary purposes. The northern area is known as the Trans-Kai and the southern area is known as the Cape. The position of the disease in the Transvaal is that it is endemic in some extent in six or seven districts. In some of those districts—only one or two farmers are affected in others five or six.

The most widespread infection exists in the Pretoria district, where a very serious spread of the disease took place two or three years ago. Fortunately, the epidemic of disease there and the fact that the district was largely supervised with dipping and hand dressing has been made since such spreading and controlling the disease during the past two years.

**Dipping in Force.**  
On the infected farms of which there were about 90, there are tanks and on a very large number of those farms surrounding compounds.

About 450 tanks have been covered in that district since the epidemic there. Out of those 90 approved farms, I think I am correct in stating that only two or three in the East Coast Province have had two deaths have taken place. In fact, there are all over the Province. I think you will gather that this disease only exists in that Province to a limited extent, and at present the position looks very hopeful indeed, that is when it is infected that there was so many infected cases in Natal.

Actual position in Swaziland at the present time but I think the area is fairly limited.

The policy for dealing with this disease in the Union at present is dipping, tick eradication, and hand dressing. These are the main precautions taken.

Dipping in a five day dip and in a three day dip respectively was used for some time and was, I think, given a fairly good trial in practice, but the latter was discontinued in Natal and I believe in other areas also.

The aim is to carry out dipping and hand dressing under official supervision on every infected area in order to see that the dipping material is of proper strength and that all the cattle are dipped, and hand dressed.

The result that has been obtained has had a much smaller staff than at present. It was impossible to do this for large numbers of tanks, but in many cases dips were not kept up to the standard strength required and heavy work was done when.

Five day dipping can be supervised by the staff now employed on the farms, but a shorter interval dipping is necessary to ensure dipping at the shorter intervals mentioned.

Another objection to three day dipping is the cattle have to drive to dip in long distances to the tank. It is not so in the two day dip, where the cattle would get very little rest, and especially in winter time when they are in poor condition.

We have at the present time sufficient staff to maintain an inspection of all infected areas on every dipping day, and only in certain cases have any exceptions been made on farms where only one death has occurred on a farm and where a spread of disease is not expected. In such cases the period of supervision have been extended to ten days.

**In the Reserve.**  
About 450 tanks have been reserved by Government in native reserves. All work in connection with dipping in native reserves is carried out under official supervision, i.e., the Government provides the dipping material and supervises the actual dipping of the cattle. The natives have to bring the cattle to the tanks on the day set apart for dipping.

Regulations are in force which prescribe the intervals at which cattle shall be dipped and authority also exists for fixing the hour. It is not a simple matter to reach this stage, for in regard to the number of dipping tanks and better supervision the aim is to concentrate the material and therefore every effort is being made towards that end. The houses are built with the tanks nearby, and made, and where official tick eradication measures have been carried out, there is the greatest difficulty in regard to the eradication of East Coast fever in the Kingdom of the Transvaal, especially now dipping is being generally carried out throughout the country. I am now referring more particularly to Natal, all the other areas are being supervised regarding deaths or disease and in sending reports. The Eastern

Provinces are well advanced for the question of tick eradication, which the United States of America is spending large sums of money on the work.

**Dr. V. J. Doolittle:** "Since 1917 this disease does not exist in Port Natal, East Africa. The last case was reported in the Transvaal in the commencement of August, in July, 1917 all cattle were removed by order of the Government."

Eighteen months having passed since the removal of the last case a fresh stock was introduced there and so far no new case has been reported.

The Redwater, Anaplasmosis, as well as infection with *Flaccidus* infection are rare in the Transvaal, the important ones are frequently attacked many of them dying of redwater if they are not vaccinated with Typhoid vaccine. Very valuable imported dip has been used against redwater and anaplasmosis.

The vaccine against redwater and anaplasmosis is prepared at the Veterinary Research Laboratory, which has been killed in the district of Lorenzo Marques by the outbreak of influenza. This proves, in my opinion, that the virulence of those two diseases is much more powerful than in the Transvaal. The Natal area is very rare. The Philadelphia virus is the rarest among the ticks and the treatment of typhoid has been very satisfactory.

The heartwater exists in the Southern Districts making some villages scarcely.

**Dipping Tanks**  
The building of tanks in Port Natal, East Africa was found to be very costly, each dipping tank cost about £200.

At present 25 public dipping tanks in the Southern districts, and three dipping tanks in the Transvaal, are being built with heartwater. Dipping is being to avoid overall stock. Public dipping tanks in my opinion are the best means of the transmission of disease such as Anthrax, etc."

**Mr. W. M. Power:** The Veterinary Research Laboratory has the only one where East Coast Fever has been eradicated. I don't think there is any other country where it has been entirely stamped out.

Another point is that in the early days in the Trans-Kai another system of dealing with the disease was adopted and this was by incision. In those days there were no dipping tanks. It was assumed that the only means of transport, viz., oxen, should be kept on the infected farms.

The incision was devised by Sir A. Thwaiter and was carried out by Veterinary Officers on a very large scale. The result was that about 60 per cent of the cattle were saved by this method, where in the early days there had been a heavy loss without incision or dipping. It was not an ideal system of dealing with the disease, as it perpetuated it, but it served its purpose at the time. As dipping came into force we realized that this was a chance of eradicating the disease by dipping. Where therefore are situated in such a position that it will be possible to combat this disease at a high cost worth while considering amounts of incision.

**Mr. H. H. Hendry:** "Did the disease occur before to the Transvaal?"

**Mr. W. M. Power:** "No opinion was met with so far as I am aware but it was not compulsory. If they bring through the incision, this method has been generally infected with it and it is major that they were allowed to proceed with the work on the farms."

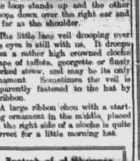

RINDERPEST OVERSEAS. Veterinary Science Advances in Belgium.

'SILENT' VACCINATION. The Standard of Buenos Aires has the following article on rinderpest vaccination against rinderpest as studied in Belgium, and notes how it is being introduced in the primary stages of Vaccination of Ostia against Rinderpest.
