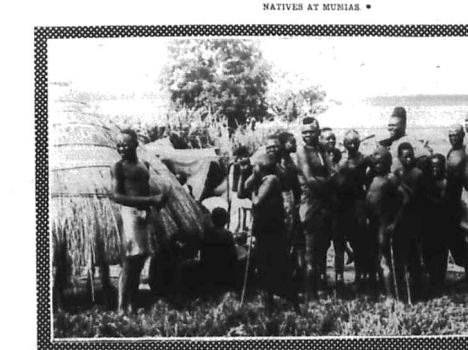

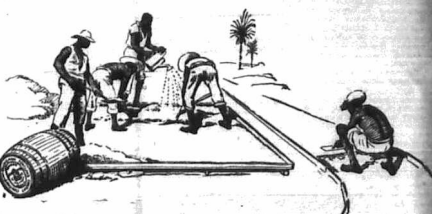

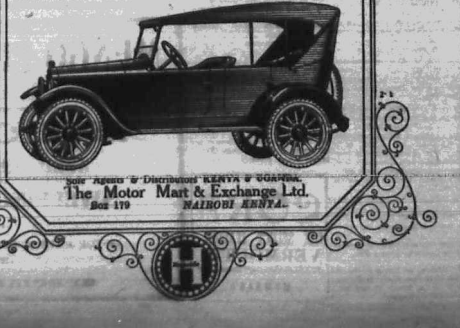

The Ministry of Pensions, London, desire to bring the following announcement to the notice of His Officers. Names, Non-Commissariat Officers and Men in Imperial Naval, Military and Air Forces who have been resident continuously overseas and who are entitled to the first Act of 1922, and to whom awards have been made by the Ministry of Pensions in respect of that Act.

The British War Pensions Act, 1912 (Section 6), declares awards to be made before the 10th August, 1927, to be final awards if they have not since that date been varied by the Ministry of Pensions. The Act provides for a right of appeal to an independent Tribunal against a final award, and the Tribunal is empowered to confirm, increase, decrease or refuse such final award. The right of appeal must be exercised within certain periods. Transmittals which are indicated below. In the absence of Transmittals which are indicated below. In the absence of a successful appeal to the Tribunal a final award cannot be questioned by a soldier.

For the purposes of the Act, and the Regulations made under it, a final award is a decision, declared to be final, on the rate of disablement (or pay) and also in the case of a final weekly allowance as to the period to which the rate of disablement applies, or as to the Grade if (or) graded.

The awards now declared by the Statute to be final are of the following classes:

- (1) Awards of permanent retired pay or pensions.
 - (2) Awards of "all disablement."
 - (3) Awards where the State of disablement is certified to be less than 1 per cent.
 - (4) Final weekly allowance and gratuity (awarded before the 14th April, 1919).
 - (5) Final weekly allowance and gratuity (awarded between the 14th April, 1919, and the 10th August, 1924).
- In the case of awards falling within clauses (1), (2), (3) and (4), (above), the latest date on which notice of appeal can be given is the 31st March, 1929, in the case given in clause (5) (the latest date for officers and men whether resident overseas or not) is 30th February, 1925.
