My Lord.

With reference to Your Lordship's despatch
No.135 of the 13th of March last I have the honour to
report that Messrs.Stedman and Muonaghten have accepted
permanent and pensionable employment on the terms laid
down and letters of appointment will be issued to them
accordingly.

2. With regard to Mr.A.E.Bush, Assistant Engineer, I now, at the renewed instance of the Commissioner of Public Forks have the honour to submit for Your Lordship's favourable consideration that he be placed on the same footing as Messrs-Stedman and Madmagnten i.e. that he be made permanent and pensionable from the slat of April 1805 at

a salary of £250 rising by annual increments of £10 to £500, the increments dating from his first appointment to the post.

- There would appear to be some doubt as to Mr. Cresswell's status in the service, which I should be glad to see removed.
- Sir James Hayes Sadler in forwarding the 1908-09 estimates enclosed a memorandum from the Commissioner of Public Works which amongst other matters contained a list of officials who in Mr. Watts opinion should be placed on the permanent and pensionable staff.
- 5. Lord Elgin when forwarding the estimates to the Lords of the Treasury supported Mr. Watts proposals (paragraph 34 Colonial Office to Treasury of 29th February 1908) and the Treasury in reply stated "subject therefore to the observations which follow My Lores accept the several proposals which are submitted" (Treasury to Colonial Office 1st April 1908). Cresswell's name was included in the list and it was consequently

consequently assumed that he become a permanent and pensionable Officer.

- 6. In this connection I would invite Your Lordship's attention to paragraph 9 of Sir James Hayes Sadler's despatch No. 460 of the 11th of September 1908 with regard the Proposed promotion of Mr. Cresswell to the rank of Executive Engineer, for which prevision has been made in the sanctioned estimates.
- 7. He is most highly reported on by Mr. Watts and I should be glad therefore if Your hordship would approve this recommendation.
