Gentlemen,

I am directed by His Excellency the Governor to refer to the agreement dated 11th. October 1908, between yourselves and Mr. N. B. Neilan, Junatic Asylum Warder, in the East Africa Protectorate.

- 2. A clause (No.7) has been inserted in this agreement by which Mr. Neilan is entitled to house allowance at the rate of £:0.0.0 per annum.
- 3. In Mr. Nailan's case it is imperative that he should occupy special quarters at the Asylum and provision for the erection of these quarters was included in the current year's estimates.
- to the house allowance provided in his agreement whether he occupies Government Quarters or not
- f am accordingly directed to request that in future agreements the insertion of any provision for some small be qualified by the addition of some small clause as "when not assigned free Government Quarters".
- adhere to the ordinary practice of stating that the officer will be entitled to free Government Quanters or an ellowance in lieu thereof.

2. A copy of the standard of agreement (Classe 1 and 2) as approved by the Secretary of State and now in force is enclosed for your information and I beg to draw your attention to the wording of the quarters clause (Clause 4 of the Schedule).
