Sir,

With reference to Mr. Fiddes' letter 262 E.A. of the 17th ultimo conveying the approval of the Secretary of State of the appointment of Mr. M. A. M. Van de Velde Assistant Auditor in East Africa to be Local Auditor of Uganda from the date when Mr. Bowring ceases to draw pay from Uganda funds, I am directed by the Comptroller and Auditor General to acquaint you, for the information of Lord Crewe, that, to fill the vacancy in the East African Audit Staff which will be caused by this promotion he has selected Mr. R. R. H. Jebb, an Assistant Auditor in Sierra Leone, who is at present on leave in this country.

2. In order to prevent an undue depletion of the East African Staff I am to request that Mr. Jebb may be allowed to sail by the steamer leaving Marseill on 30th October although this arrangement will cause a slight overlapping of his salary with that of Mr. Van de Velde

3. Mr. Jebb's return leave in respect of his service in Sierra Leone began on the 25th September and would expire on 24th November and I am to request that, in the circumstances, he may be allowed to retain the full salary to 30th September which he has already been paid, and to draw half salary from Sierra Leone funds from that date to the date of his starting for East Africa.

4. To fill the vacancy in the Sierra Leone Staff caused by the transfer of Mr. Jebb, the Comptroller and Auditor General has selected Mr. J. Twells, an Examiner in this Department, whose

physical fitness for service in West Africa has been ascertained.

5. Should the Secretary of State approve these arrangements I am to request that the Crown Agents may be instructed to secure a passage to Mombasa for Mr:Jebb by the Steamer leaving Marseilles on 30th October and to advance him one month's salary at the rate of £320 per annum, and also to secure a passage to Freetown for Mr:Twells by the Steamer leaving Liverpool on the 24th November and to advance him £25, being one month's salary of his post.
