Prince Henry XXII of Reuss, Oberleutnant & in spite of the German navy, intends to make a tour of investigation in Africa in May next in the course of which he proposes to visit Cape Colony, Natal, the Transvaal and Rhodesia, and on his return journey British East Africa and Uganda.

Under instructions from my Government I have the honour to ask you to be good enough to obtain if possible for the Prince introductions to the authorities of the British colonies mentioned.
