Representations have been made through Uganda for permission to allow ivory coming from Congo fulfilling Uganda conditions but not one being passed through E.A.P. till you sanction

The situation referred to in this telegram is described in our letter to the Foreign Office of the 20th of July on Gov. 21031 ag. It is briefly this. Ivory between the weights of 11 lbs. and 30 lbs. may legally be introduced into the East Africa Protectorate for the purpose of transit if it was lawfully collected and possessed in Uganda, but cannot be legally possessed in the East Africa Protectorate if it proceeds from other territories than Uganda. It is admitted that our position in the matter is untenable, and that, if the Belgian Government, or any other foreign government, were to press for the extension to their territories of the privilege allowed to Uganda ivory by the East Africa Protectorate law, it would be difficult, if not impossible, to refuse to make the alteration desired. We have, however, agreed with the Foreign Office that no alteration
