£6000 was provided in the Estimates
 for 1909-10 for special expenditure on
 combating stock diseases. To this the Govt.
 was allowed only last month (on ^{Govt.}
~~1909-10~~)
 to add a further sum of £5000.

£2713 was provided for expenditure on
 the same service in the recently approved
 Estimates for 1910-11, or £3973 if the salaries
 of the special stock inspectors are included.
 The Govt. has also been allowed to add
 £5000 to this amount (on ^{Govt.}
~~3863~~)
 the condition that he makes equivalent
 reductions elsewhere in the Estimates.

Reply to the following effect:-
I am prepared to recommend to the Treasury that you should be permitted to incur additional expenditure up to half the amount of the increase in estimate of revenue. But this would more properly be done in connection with revised estimates, when you have shown how you propose to effect necessary reallocations indicated in my despatch of 4th March No. 114. Also I should be glad to have details of proposed expenditure on veterinary quarantine. In the meantime large amount already sanctioned for this purpose will suffice to keep precautionary operations going.


