My Lord,

I have the honour to report that Mr.H.W. Barnes, Steam Lorry Driver, Public Works Department, has recently died very suddenly leaving a widow and ohild in poor circumstances.

- 2. He was formerly in the Royal Navy and joined the Protectorate Service in June 1907 and was within one month of completing his agreement when he would have been entitled to a free steamer passage and three months leave on full pay.
- 3. In view of the fact that Mrs.Barnes is prectically destitute I have the honour to recommend for Your Lordship's most fevourable consideration that she may be given as a compacsionate allowance the £60 which Mr.Bernes would have earned but for his sudden death, that is one months pay and 3 months' leave pay at the rate of £180 a year.
- 4. Mrs. Barnes has relatives in South Africa and I have granted her a ord class passage by Union Castle Line to Cape Town.
- I trust Your Lordship will approve my action in the matter.
