Secretary Harcourt that, in consideration of the facts now adduced, My Lords sanction his proposal that a married officer of either of the two Protectorates mentioned should, when accompanied by his wife or family to or from East Africa, be granted an allowance of £10 for the double journey or of £5 for the single journey, on the understanding that this concession will remain in force for so long only as the existing disparity in the rates of the various shipping companies continues.
