In the circumstances represented by Mr. Secretary Harcourt in Sir C. Lucas's letter of the 27th ultimo (30813/11), the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury approve of the appointment of an additional clerk for the Land Board of the East Africa Protectorate on a 30 months' agreement in the first instance, with salary at the rate of £150 per annum, rising by annual increments of £10 to £200 per annum.
