I have the honour to report that, owing to representations made to me by the Commissioner of Police in respect of the low rate of pay enjoyed by the European Police Constables in this Protectorate and the enhanced cost of living due to the war, I discussed with my Executive Council the question of granting these officers a War Bonus till such time as the cost of living in this country becomes more normal.

2. I have accordingly approved the grant of bonuses to these European Police Constables as from 1st instant on the following

scale:-

Salary.

3. I am of opinion that under present
conditions it is practically impossible for an
officer of this class to live on his pay, and
I have sanctioned the bonuses with a view to
assisting these men to keep out of debt. I
trust my action will meet with your approval.
