

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt
of your despatch No. 413 of June 17th relating to the
rental of certain enemy-owned premises at Mombasa,
and to inform you that the premises to which reference
is made in paragraph 2 consist of a building owned
by Mr. C. Schwentafsky, an Austrian subject who is at
present in his native country.

2. This building was rented by Government from
the owner a considerable time previous to the out-
break of hostilities, and has been and still is
occupied by the Conservancy, Survey and Forest
Departments, and the Medical Officer of Health.

3. The rent which is Rs. 600 per mensem is being
paid as it falls due to the Custodian of Enemy
Property, whose fees, amounting to 5%, are deducted
from the receipts.
