No. 463. August 7th. Owing to serious outbreak pleuro-pneumonia Masai Reserve am taking steps to endeavour to stamp out disease by inoculation. Disease not only threatens to decimate(?) Masai stock but is serious danger to whole stock industry Protectorate. For this work it will be necessary to engage special staff of inoculators who would act(?) under direction Veterinary Department. It is proposed to levy fees amounting to 50 cents(?) per head which should cover cost of inoculation other than that which can be found from sanction Estimates. Number of Masai cattle estimated at nearly 800,000 head.
