Protectorate and applications have now been received from clerks who have, under the new system, been transferred to this Protectorate to be allowed to continue under the previous conditions.

I do not consider it right that these clerks should lose by their transfer and I have consequently approved of the privilege of house allowance to Customs Clerks taken over from the Uganda Protectorate being continued when shey are not occupying Government Quarters. This privilege should not, I think, cease on promotion, as the amount lost thereby would not be compensated for by the increase of pay on promotion. As heretofore Customs Clerks will occupy available free quarters in Uganda and East African Customs Stations when it is difficult or impossible to obtain other than Government quarters. I trust that you will approve my action in this matter.
