Bright Williams died on 3rd June 1917, from Blackwater fever. On admission to Hospital he was exceedingly bloodless and weak and never had a chance with his illness. He did not suffer much pain and was comparatively bright and quite conscious to the end. He received a Christian burial by one of the Chaplains attached to the Carrier Depot Hospital here and is interred in the part of the cemetery here reserved for British Officers and men.
