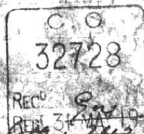

Sir.
With reference to your letter of the 15th inst and my conversation with Mr Bottomly of the 26th inst I have the honour to inform you that I am convinced some misunderstanding exists.

When I applied for the position of Assistant Game warden in December 1918 I was informed by the Chief Game warden Nairobi that it would take at least two, and possibly six months before the appointment was sanctioned by the Colonial Office.

I therefore decided to spend a few recuperation months in South Africa and England. I gave the Chief Game warden my Cape Town address and when I left that place I posted him my London address.

On the 6th April I left Cape Town for England.

The following cable was dispatched
to the Chief Secretary Nairobi to my
Tawn address, and Owas re called
me in London by my sister from
here

I received my sister's re cable
London on the 11th May - and I
