Please see 294/19. I have looked up the Rabies Order but that places no restriction on export. I think we are safe in

letting them go as if they are suspected cases of rabies is actually safe & before they will have to be destroyed (see copy of Rabies order attached). I reply that we have no objection.

As he would presumably have to ship them from London, he would need a licence from the Board of Agriculture under section 11(1)(a) of the Dog Act of the 17th April 1919.

I refer you to 294/2/EA, but say that it is possible that the Govt. may at any time impose a restriction in view of the outbreak of rabies in this country & that if such a restriction were imposed it is impossible to say exactly what the regulations would be and how they would affect dogs in transit at the time of exportation, and also as to the necessity of a licence if the dogs are shipped from a prohibited area, or shipped together with copies of the Gazette to Govt.
