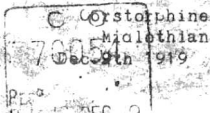

with reference to your letter No. 46144/19 dated August 18th 1919 in reply to my application for priority passages to East Africa for my wife and myself, we have now got a baby of a month old which we want to take out with us together with a nurse.

I have consulted the Union Castle Mail Steamship Co. about the ~~and~~ <sup>mother and</sup> they say, that ~~although~~ there will be no difficulty about the baby as it does not require an extra berth, but that I must obtain priority authority from you for the nurse.
