My Lord,

I have the honour to report with reference to the correspondence enclosed in Your Lordship's despatch No. 306 of the 4th ultimo that the only plan relating to the East Africa Cotton Syndicate's application for land on the Tana River which can be traced is that forwarded herewith, which was sent to the Land Office by Mr. Watcham, the Agent of the Syndicate.

2. There are no specific local objections to the adoption of this plan, so far as I can ascertain, but until the Recorder of Titles has been able to visit the district in which the property is situated it is difficult to say what rights of private ownership may exist.

3. I would therefore suggest that if the plan is accepted such acceptance should be subject to the proviso that alterations in view of native and other rights may be made in the boundaries when the actual survey of the land is completed. The plan itself should be endorsed to that effect.
