IMPORTS ACCOUNT FOR INCREASED VOLUME

WEST AFRICA's trade with the rest of the world rose to its highest level in the year ended in 1955. The annual figures, as compiled by the Customs and Excise Department, show a record volume of imports valued at £224,033,838—an increase of more than 25 per cent on the £178,448,000 of the previous year. The increase in the volume of trade was due primarily to a rise in the volume of imports, which rose from £118,499,765 in 1954 to £215,000,000 in 1955, an increase of more than 80 per cent. Exports, which rose from £65,534,073 in 1954 to £109,033,838 in 1955, an increase of 65 per cent, were also a major factor in the increase.
