RENEWED CONFIDENCE IN RESULT OF WAR

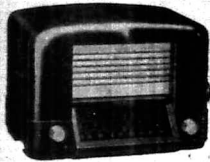

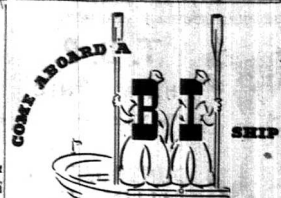

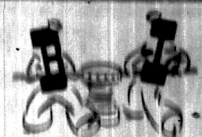

Alleged Shooting Of Native

Allegation that a native was shot by a soldier in the Nyeri district has been investigated by the Assistant Inspector Brown.

A sitting of the Nyeri District Court took place on the 11th inst. before Mr. Justice Hastings, who was presiding. The case was charged with the murder of a native named Mwangi on the 11th inst. at Nyeri. The accused was a soldier named Mwangi, who was a member of the 1st Battalion, King's African Rifles. The prosecution was conducted by Mr. Philip, Acting Solicitor-General, who opened the proceedings by briefly outlining the case as brought before the court. The first witness called was Dr. C. J. Timms, M.B. Government Pathologist, of Nairobi, who stated that on April 10th, he carried out a post mortem on the body of an African native. Death was due to a gunshot wound in the chest, the bullet first striking the body in the space between the third and fourth ribs from the left. It passed through the body in a straight line, and left the chest about one inch below the armpit. By Horace Thorogood. NOW that war-time sends its urgent S.O.S. to the farmer, it is a pleasure to propose, for the Book Club of the Month, a book about the land.

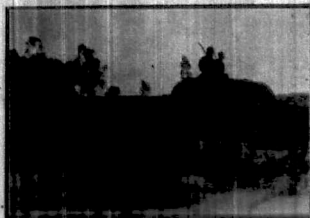

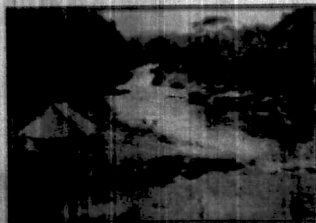

Signs of Progress

Being extracts from a report submitted by Mr. D. A. Wilson, the Agricultural Adviser to the Land and Agricultural Bank of Southern Rhodesia.

Generally speaking there is a tendency amongst the progressive farmers in the country to regard animal husbandry as one of the important factors which lead to eventual success in any form of agricultural activity. No farm is complete without either cattle or sheep.

On the majority of farms it is noticeable that cattle have not increased to any appreciable extent over a period of years. This is partly accounted for by the farmer's feeling that it is not profitable to keep a large number of cattle.

The heavy rainfall which occurred last season proved somewhat disastrous to sheep owners and many losses were caused by inter-current parasites, especially amongst young lambs.

The higher prices which have been obtained for cattle and pigs have led to a belief that future prospects are bright and that it is worth while to invest in these animals.

The Control of Animal Products

Being a Broadcast Talk given by Mr. Daubney, C.M.G., O.B.E., the Director of Veterinary Services, on Thursday evening, June 6, 1946.

NO doubt most of you heard, or have since read, the communiqué which was issued by the Committee of Animal Control that was broadcast last week on the radio.

The measures as the communiqué indicated, are necessitated by an immediate and very large increase in the consumption of food-stuffs and the plan is to interpose between the producer and the consumer—military and civilian—a regulatory mechanism which will smooth out, so far as possible, the peaks of production on the one hand and consumption on the other, in order to meet the fluctuating requirements of the consumer.

Changes of an even more sweeping character must be made in the industry. Our production of bacon piglets must be rapidly increased to give more to the public. The necessary expansion of production has been taken by placing an embargo on the slaughter of pigs for more than 12 months.

Specific mention was made in the communiqué of the need for slaughter and supplies of fresh meat. This is a very important matter and the industry will be asked to supply the country, but any attempt to increase the quantity of meat available will be met with a view to maintaining the standard of living.



Ambition is a besetting sin of the Duce in that he has never been satisfied with a world for Italians to rebuild a long departed glory. There is no doubt at all that the treaty which Italy signed in 1919 after the last war had become a personal issue and when he came under the influence of Hitler and saw the whole technique of aggression applied to another undefeated nation, the ambition which he had employed for his youth has become more convincing with him. His part in the attack on the democracies became then clear. He had to avert his hour and it was calculated both in Berlin and Rome to be that of the greatest embarrassment for the Allies.

It is not surprising that while there is anger in many parts of the world regarding this duplicity, this collusion and reaction against our friendly peoples at their time of stress, there is real regret that the Italian people, who are so braced with the German nation, in assessing ruthlessness, should have been brought into a war which is being fought by Britain and France to save the finer things in that civilisation to which Italy has made so noble a contribution throughout her history. But that regret cannot turn us from our duty or make less vigorous the effort which we are giving. From our point of view Mussolini has made a tragic error in exposing his people to the horrors of a war which they did not think they had not thought that there is in it spoils for him and his nation.

Now that anger is passing and it being replaced by cold reason we need not underestimate the magnitude of the task Italy has to accomplish.

INCREASED GOLD PRODUCTION

Expenditure During Year Nearly Half Million

On the 1st June an area of approximately 800 square miles, previously held under Ranthane Prospecting License and situated in the Western Kavirondo District, with the exception of a small area, was opened to general prospecting and mining.

The work of the Department's Assay Office and Laboratory has largely increased. During 1939, 4,677 samples were received and 10,245 assays were made.

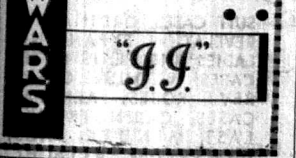
