The Minister gave the Council three assurances: that he would direct the Board to employ as many young farmers and holders practising with the export maize marketing Board and Maize Control as far as was reasonable, and certainly to the end of 1959.

The Minister gave the Council three assurances: that he would direct the Board to employ as many young farmers and holders practising with the export maize marketing Board and Maize Control as far as was reasonable, and certainly to the end of 1959.

It was his intention also to direct the Board that exports of surplus maize should be by open tender unless there was some good reason to the contrary. The third assurance was that members of the Board should be freely informed that they would be expected to attend meetings of producers to discuss the annual reports of the Board.
