Retention of European ties urged

Continued the American programme of economic and technical assistance for Africa in the coming financial year. Mr. Joseph Stettin, director of the Congressional committee that the Defense Dept. did not seek to reduce aid to Africa.

THE STEP TO SUPERSONIC AGE

Study group calls for trial designs

A SUPERSONIC airline will carry 124 passengers on the London-Park route at more than 1,400 m.p.h. according to the British aircraft industry's design plan.

This was announced by the Minister of Supply, Denis Healey, who said the Government-appointed research group which is studying the project is the Supersonic Transport Aircraft Committee. It had recommended that detailed design work on the aircraft should start immediately.

The group's recommendations are expected to be agreed to by the Government. Mr. Jones was "carefully studied" by Mr. John Iain (Crosby), who had advised whether a report from the research group had been submitted.

21 years of research

PREMIERS AGREE IN LONDON

Common policy

BRITAIN and France agreed to a common policy on nuclear tests in London. The agreement was reached after a meeting between the two countries' prime ministers, Harold Wilson and Georges Pompidu.

The agreement states that both countries will work together to reduce the number of nuclear tests and to improve the safety of nuclear power plants. It also calls for a ban on nuclear tests in the atmosphere.

Kenya released from prison

RESTRICTION Orders were lifted on the Kenya Daily Nation newspaper. The newspaper had been under a strict censorship regime since it was founded in 1952.

The lifting of the restriction orders is seen as a sign of progress in Kenya's move towards independence. It allows the newspaper to report on local and international news more freely.

Russia exchanges protests with U.S.

The United States and the Soviet Union have exchanged protests over the activities of the KGB in the United States. The U.S. State Department has accused the KGB of espionage and sabotage.

The Soviet Union has responded by accusing the U.S. of harboring KGB agents and of interfering in Soviet internal affairs. This exchange of protests is part of the ongoing Cold War tensions between the two superpowers.

£1,000,000 CUT IN KENYA ESTIMATES

Mr. Vasey's proposals

CUTTING of Government expenditure in the 1959-60 financial year has enabled the Minister for Finance, Mr. Vasey, to present expenditure estimates which show a saving of more than £1,000,000 on the revised estimates for 1958-59.

Mr. Vasey's expenditure estimates were laid before the House by the Minister in Kenya Legislative Council yesterday. Increased allocations are suggested for the posts of Ministers. The estimates provide for the supplying of 2,520,000 cigarettes with £300,000 in the revised estimates for the financial year.

£140,000 rise in Public Debt

The Public Debt rises by about £140,000 to £2,270,000 in the 1959-60 financial year. This is the result of an economic boom and is likely to continue for as long as the Colony has a development programme. The estimate is £140,000 more than the £2,130,000 in 1958-59.
