## BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S POSITION ON FUTURE OF KENYA

### No betrayal of responsibility

The Colonial Secretary, Mr. Lennox-Boyd, made a statement during a debate in the House of Commons last night on the future of Kenya. He asserted that the British Government will not force a date when it would be possible for Kenya to become a republic, but that it will be possible for the British Government to surrender its ultimate responsibility for the future of the Colony.

The aim of the British Government in Kenya, as in other dependent territories, was to build a nation based on parliamentary institutions and self-governing institutions which secured for its people a fair share of living and working hours, opportunities in its industry.

There was no reason why the transfer of power should not be made in 1962, but that stage had not yet been reached.

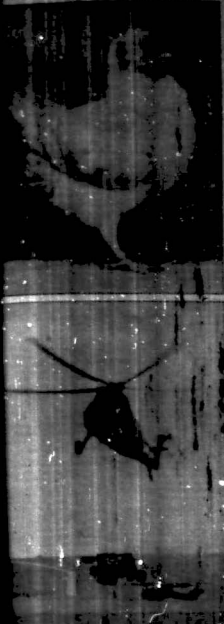
