Possibility of Extension To Civil Mails

Considerable interest in the "air-graph" mail system has been aroused in East Africa and the possibility of its introduction here for civil use is now under consideration.

For some time now following the success of the scheme for military mails in the Middle East, the British and East African Postal authorities have had the matter under active consideration. No more information than this was available when inquiries were made in official quarters by the E.A. Standard, recently, but they have revealed the matter sympathetically. The Association of Postal, Telegraph and Telephone Engineers and the E.A. Standard are also giving attention to this question—which is of the utmost importance to the community.

There are, of course, difficulties to be overcome, but the scheme, especially under war conditions, offers many advantages. It would give the private individual and the business man alike the same direct and immediate communication as the commercial traveler who is universally welcomed. At the same time, it would prevent the passage of military and sensitive information in East Africa, which would be a matter of great importance in the event of any war days to such a considerable extent. Restriction Of Mombasa Forces Trade Licences Canteen Opposed

The question of the restriction, or otherwise of traders' licences in Mombasa, has been the subject of a meeting of the Municipal Council held on the 10th inst. after being dealt with at the last meeting of the Council. The Municipal Council was the subject of further discussion at the subsequent meeting of the management committee of the Mombasa Municipal Chamber of Commerce. When the Municipal Council dealt with the matter a recommendation was made that the Council should instruct the Police to refuse to issue licences to traders who were not members of the Chamber of Commerce. This recommendation was given for the purpose of restricting the number of licences issued to traders who were not members of the Chamber of Commerce.

The Services Canteen at Mombasa, since it came into existence about fifteen months ago, has played an important part in the life of the town both from the point of view of residents and members of the Forces. The Canteen came into being as a result of a public meeting held on June 18, 1940, organized by Mrs. R. G. Sargent, of the Institution, Mombasa, and Mr. J. H. C. Boulton, (Provisional Commissioner) and Major R. H. La Fontaine, (Liaison Officer). From that time onwards, the Canteen has been supported by the Superintendent of Police, Mombasa, and has been fully supported by the Government.

As a result of this meeting the Municipal Council was requested to appoint a committee of five members to investigate the matter and to report to the Council. This committee was appointed on the 10th inst. and has since that time been working on the matter. The committee has reported to the Council that it is of the opinion that the restriction of licences to members of the Chamber of Commerce is not justified. The committee has recommended that the Council should instruct the Police to issue licences to all traders who are willing to pay the licence fee.

The Chamber's management committee also expressed its opposition to the restriction of licences. 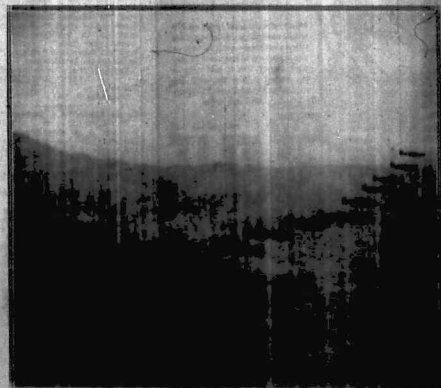

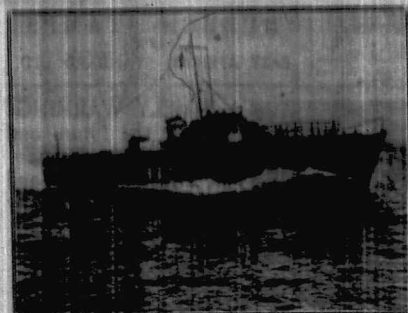



Considerable interest in the "argraph" mail system has been expressed in East Africa and the possibility of its extension to the civil mail is now under investigation.

For some time now following the success of the scheme for military mail in the Middle East, the British and East African Postal authorities have been considering an "active consideration". No more details than were available were included in an official circular by the E.A. Standard, but the impression gained was that both sides were working for the extension of the Association of Chambers of Commerce and Industries of Eastern Africa is also giving attention to this question—owing to the importance of the commercial community.
