NO LARGE SCALE IRRIGATION POSSIBLE IN DELTA AREA OR MIDDLE REACHES

Following is the second (and last) article on the recently issued report of the "Tana River Expedition 1994." In it the Commissioners outline their £2,000,000 canal scheme and say that its main jourification is the removal of the spectre of future famines now broading over Kenya.

They feel that the only real remedy of the overstocking posi-tion is to change the habits of the Natives by gradual conversion from a pastoral to an agricultural life. Taking the long view of their proposed scheme for the irrigation of an area of probably 366,800 acres, the Commissioners consider that the Tana River is to-day the most valuable asset that Kenya possessor.

Proposals are also made for the expansion of a promising rice growing industry now in existence but requiring help and direction.

The 1935 Budget

MUST CALL A HALT TO THE POLICY OF DRIFT

Courageous Reconstruction Required

The Keryx Budget for 1905 will be preemed to the country on Theside yets case. It is important and necessary that in view of the continuing gravity of the financial and economic outlook, the Government and the people of the Colony should be left in no doubt on the main issues which should be risited at the Budget session.

The present depression began in 1929. It has continued with unabated intensity for five years.

Effective development of this country only began after has been facing abnormal conditions.

What is the situation to-day?

Gold-mining is still in the expensive prospecting and development stage. But it is calculated, very approximate-by, that during the last two years no less a sum than £3,500,000 has been invested in Kenya goldmining alone. Gold will play its part—probably a great part—in the development of Kenya and it must continue to receive every necessary assistance and encouragement.

THE MAIN INDUSTRY

Agriculture is, however, still the main industry in Kenya. It represents the real wealth producing sources and since gold cannot be an immediate factor in restoring prosperity, consideration in all Budget questions must be given to the land and the people on it.

Coffee, which has been the mainstay of the Colony, is now suffering from a lengthening period of depressed prices and three years of drought. During the year 1933 the value of coffee exported was only £832,353 compared with £1,214,392 in 1932—a drop in one industry alone of

The Dairy Industry is losing money on every pound of butter exported. If the Colony has a normal rainy season the production will increase by leaps and bounds and the greater will be the loss.

There is no outlet for the large herds of cattle in the country. The Native Reserves, too, are overstocked to a point which is causing the loss of irreplaceable assets in soil fertility and grazing.

The Sugar Industry is in a precarious state. It is now the subject of international restriction of planting and export. Uganda, where a soft cane is used with a high sucrose content, could flood the Kenya market. Kenya plantations, are at a serious disadvantage.

Too, one of the brightest and most promising of the Colony's new industries, is no longer able to expand normal.

That is the background against which the Budget must

That is the Background against which the Dudges dust be studied by the country this year.

The Budget Session is regarded by the country as the appropriate occasion for a detailed examination both of Government's financial policy and of its economic plans. The 1935 Budget can be no exception.

There is an urgent need for emphasis on two cardinal principles—firstly recognition of the inability of the country to continue to finance its present administrative machine, and secondly the urgent need for a policy of reconstruction for immediate application.






