As soon as possible this draft will be submitted to the Districts for their comments and suggestions, and the Committee will then be able to draw up a final scheme for the approval of members, after which a Conference will be called to elect the Executive and sectional committees which will assist the Board. It will be reintroduced from the list of the constitution that these committees will each have at least one member on the Board, that the interests of each section of the industry will be represented, but as all members own more than one type of stock, the whole Board are presented for selection from the entire community.

The chairman of the Stock Owners' Association, its committee, and the representatives appointed to forward the interests of the Pie Farmers, will be all anxious to carry into effect the wishes expressed at the Annual General meeting of the Stock Owners' Association.

It is hoped that stock owners will support the remodeling Stock Owners' Association and realize the splendid opportunity for forming one powerful association to represent their best interests of stock owners.

LOCAL MARKET REPORT

FAST FEISALS FAIL

Military Defeat Crack Arab Team

One of the largest crowds seen on the Railway ground for a long time turned up last Sunday for the game between the European Military and the Mombasa Arab team. It was evident from the large percentage of natives present that most things were expected from this Mombasa Arab Feisal XI. The Arabs were well equipped with the wind, leaving the Military to defend their goal.

Strait from the kick-off the Mombasa half held the play in the Arab's half, eventually forcing a corner which was headed high outside the goal. The goal kick eased the pressure and the Arab forwards got on the move first time. There followed some end to end play with both sides making good moves but unable to finish their field their wing ends were getting some good passes. Van den Berg on the left wing was as fast as his opposition and he put over a centre which appeared an almost certain goal but Gie just missed from a good position. He looked as though the Arabs must add to their score when Pooie, harassed by Hasbi, slipped to leave the latter player in possession with only the goalkeeper to beat. Heere came out and the ball but Hasbi kicked wildly over the bar, an easy opportunity badly missed. The exchanges were all fairly even and the ball was going from goal to goal with plenty of thrills. The first goal for the Military came direct from an attack by the Arabs, when a long shot cleared by Heere went to Humphries, who put through a good pass for Gie to cut in and put in a shot to the bottom corner of the net before Mul Khanani was aware what had happened.

Shortly after this the Arabs scored again but the whistler had already been blown for off-side. Just before half-time the Military scored again, this time a real goal, from a header by Humphries direct to corner kick. The half-time whistle came

while the Ambulance men were on the field attending to Hasbi, who had received a kick while attempting to head a ball into the net.

Plan Stuck

The whole 2-1 in favour of the Military was a fast reflection on the play during this half for the passing of the Military was far superior to that of the Arabs who were inclined to play a more direct and clear style than under pressure. Still, we had been told that the Arabs would be both sides, and with the promise of greater stamina by the Arab half, which was not only a great football, which unfortunately, were not fulfilled.

The Military were immediately on the offensive from the start. Van den Berg at outside left, after putting one shot over the bar, was responsible for the Military's third goal, when the goalkeeper gathered his shot and stepped back over the goal line to dodge Everett who had been following up. This was within two minutes of the kick-off and seemed to disconcert the Arab side, who never combined effectively again for the rest of the match. Apart from Hasbi in the centre, the forwards never looked as though they were halves were playing well back this player had to do more to put in two good shots which were well saved.

One More

The native section of the crowd had started to encroach along the touch line on the European side of the ground during this half of the match until it was almost impossible to play from the stand. Fortunately there was little, as the majority of the Military was now clearly established but the ball hardly ever came over the half-way line. One further goal came to the credit of the Military when Gie headed in a free kick taken by Heere.

The final whistle came with the score 4-1 in favour of the Military, after a most disappointing second-half.

There was no doubt that the Military well deserved their win as they had knitted together into a well balanced team. The Arabs, apart from Mul Khanani, Abbas and Hasbi were below the standard of the African side who gave such a good exhibition against a Military XI of five weeks ago.

The game was refereed by Mr. W. Bird.

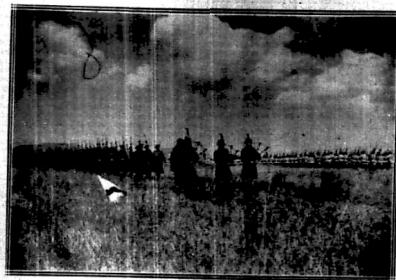

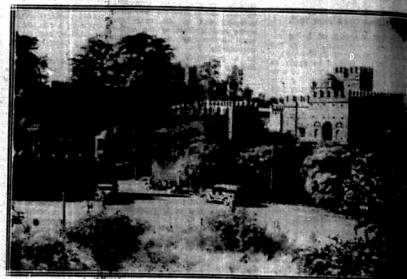

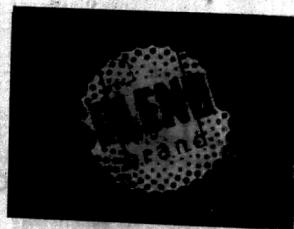

TASKS OF CUSTODIAN OF ENEMY PROPERTY

Some Of His Problems in Occupied Territory

WHILE there is no ordinary keep civil and returned after peace, an authority in occupied territory is faced with a task of enormous proportions. CANTEENS HELP OUTPUT

(FROM A CORRESPONDENT)

Recently an unusual meal was served in the dining-room of the House of Commons. A selected group of members of Parliament sampled a hot dinner brought from a north-west restaurant in containers such as others are now using to take the same sort of meals down the pit. The meal consisted of meat and vegetables with pudding to follow. It was prepared in the canteen and put in containers exactly as miners' meals are and brought to London to train operatives. The meal was piping hot, although it had been in the van for twenty-four hours.

This illustrates a development of a remarkable and now highly organized system of works canteens which grew up since war began. Its extension to the collieries is a most interesting feature. Meals under-extended for generations of miners have invariably been no more than cold stews in tin trays, with bread and cheese, maybe an apple, wafers, meat sandwiches, and always milk. The miners' great meal of the day was a big steaming affair when he got home from the pit and had removed the grime by bathing in a household tub in front of the kitchen fire.

Conditions in the collieries have been steadily revolutionized over a period of years, particularly in the matter of pithead baths and wash-houses. But pit canteens are a time innovation. Arrangements to supply hot meals to miners are still more recent. They aren't yet general but a start has been made and the idea has come to stay.

One a "Luxury" Now Essential The canteen system is spreading all through British industry. The second warwave. Once regarded as a luxury and a nuisance, they are now accepted as essential. They are helping to change the conditions of factory of fifty years ago into a place nearly as attractive as home. Experience has convinced the most enlightened employers as well as industrial experts and department officials that many problems of industry, not only of output, but also of absenteeism, health, accidents, labour turnover and unhealthful factory relations between workers and management, find at least part of their solution in the works canteen. Larger Units Of Government? Fires Threaten To Destroy The Old City

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT] London.

THRILLING BATTLES

Communications from Headquarters R.A.F. Middle East received through A.C. Flinders Mackenzie state: "A South African fighter pilot in the Libyan campaign records of an enemy aircraft, in the afternoon of 19th December, was shot down by a South African fighter pilot.
