COURT MARTIAL

Officer's Alleged Corruption

An officer of the Royal Engineers, at present serving in East Africa, Captain L. McCullough, was arraigned before a General Court Martial held in the Law Courts, Nairobi, yesterday on charges of alleged corruption.

The Court consisted of a President, four members, and a sumo. Mr. L. Kaplan acted for the accused, and the prosecution is being conducted by Major Wilkinson. Captain McCullough pleaded not guilty to six charges under the Army Act. The charges alleged that he had been an officer of His Majesty's forces did:

(1) In Nairobi, on August 8, 1940, corruptly agreed to accept the sum of £1,530 from B. C. Patel as part of reward for the supply of labour for the construction of War Department works.

(2) At Nyet on October 20, 1940, corruptly agreed to accept £642 from B. C. Patel as part of reward for the supply of labour for the construction of War Department works.

(3) At Gilgil, about July 15, 1940, corruptly agreed to accept a retainer of 500 shillings for the supply of goods for the use of a number of women in the Atlas New Mills, Uganda;

(4) At Gilgil, about August 1, 1940, corruptly agreed to accept commission of 5 per cent on the supply of all goods supplied to the War Department by the Service Stores, Limited, and orders placed by him or by the R.E. Stores, Nairobi, with the said Service Stores, Nairobi;

(5) At Nyet, on October 8, 1940, corruptly agreed to accept £600 as part of a consideration for having placed with Universal Stores, Nairobi, a contract for the supply of goods for the War Department at Nyet and elsewhere.

Objections
Mr. Kaplan put forward an objection to the trial proceeding and tendered several grounds for the consideration of the Court. These included insufficiency of time to prepare the defence and certain statements from defence witnesses, non-consultation with the defence with regard to the date fixed for the trial, and the date fixed clashed with the session of the Court of Appeal in which he, Mr. Kaplan, was engaged; insufficiency of time in which to hold over the trial for defence to submit advice; certain difficulties with regard to the evidence of defence witnesses; and, lastly, a plea that the accused had not sufficiently time to stage a prepared trial.

Mr. Kaplan also offered the opinion that the trial might take a fortnight. Major Wilkinson opposed the adjournment of the case on the grounds that the defence had had sufficient time to prepare, and that both the Deputy Judge Advocate, General's Department, and the President and Members of Court had a considerable amount of work to be done in addition to the present trial.

The Court closed for a few minutes.

Spain And Poland

January 23.
The Spanish government has requested the British Legation in Madrid and has asked the Polish Minister to apply for his passport and leave immediately.

The Polish Government in London has asked the British Legation in Madrid to take charge of Polish affairs in Spain and to look after British nationals in that country.

Master Lonsdale has the proposal for the closing down of the Legation in Madrid for the Polish subjects in Madrid has been being discussed in an informal manner.

It is felt that the real explanation for the closing down of the Legation is partly due to German pressure and partly to Spanish reluctance at the recent agreement signed between Stalin and General Franco, part of which provided for the raising of a Polish army in Russia. (Reuter.)

Von Papen to See Hitler

Lady Patricia Ramsey, the only daughter also walked behind the coffin, which was draped with the Royal Standard. The coffin was borne by Grenadier Guardsmen. (Reuter.)

S. AFRICAN NEWS SUMMARY

Petrol rationing will be introduced in the Union from February 1st when petrol will only be obtainable by coupon. The scheme provides for a monthly ration which will be determined by the weight of the vehicle, and will allow travelling up to a maximum of 400 miles a month. This ration will be general. However, increased owner of a car will be entitled to that ration. For the time being the rationing will apply only to motor-cars and motor-buses, and while the issue of petrol for lorries and other vehicles will not be rationed on the basis applicable to motor-cars, Mr. Stutterford, should any individual feel that a higher ration should be allowed to him in the interest of his business or occupation, he will be at liberty to make special application for the grant of an increased ration. The coupons will be available for one month only, making 'hoarding' impossible.

Wives In Britain

The Kerens Government has been requested by His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom to state the difficulties of the situation in regard to passages for wives at present in the United Kingdom who wish to join their families in Kenya are fully appreciated by the public.

There are at present more than 1,200 wives and children in the United Kingdom requiring passages to various parts of the Colonial Empire, and although every possible effort has been and is being made to secure passages for them it is most unlikely that accommodation will be forthcoming for some time to come except in the case of women whose presence in the Colony is deemed to be of national importance. Except in these cases all available passages are allocated in order of the date of application.

While having much sympathy with both husbands and wives in the separation caused by the war, His Majesty's Government is confident that they will appreciate that availability of passage is and must be dependent on the shipping requirements of the Services.

It is impossible at present to give any indication of what prospects of passages for wives later on may be.

Electric Light Fittings

The Kenya Information Office has issued the following:
With reference to the Defence (Control of Electrical Development) Regulations, 1941, it is notified that the Official Contract dated January 15, 1941, all persons occupying or intending to construct building requiring electric light or power installations should note that the stocks of electrical material now available locally are such that it is unlikely that permits can be granted for some time, except for essential war work.

All persons, and in particular those whose electrical wiring was in the course of installation on January 15, 1941, should note that such work may be performed now until such time as the necessary installation permit has been issued.

All persons carrying out electrical installation works are notified that the mere filing of an application does not entitle them to proceed with work, which was in hand prior to January 15, 1941, and action will be taken in any case where unauthorised work is being carried out.

U.S.A. WILL BUILD THE SHIPS

The United States Maritime Commission has been allocated more than \$60,000,000 dollars to build ships. Further appropriations will be needed to cover, Mr. Hoover said in his recent message to Congress. American shipbuilding production jumped from 2,000,000 to 6,000,000 tons last year, will rise to 8,000,000 tons this year and is expected to reach 10,000,000 tons in 1943. America is building about 25 times as many ships as Great Britain is at normal peace time.

Confidence that this vast program of shipbuilding will expand their output to this remarkable degree was expressed by Sir Arthur Salter, head of the British Shipping Commission in Washington.

It is brought about largely by mass production; instead of building each ship as a distinct unit, the workers now turn out parts of ships in assembly line and in motorized factories.

Sir Arthur Salter, asked if this was satisfactory, said that the normally-built ships had proved far more serviceable than the normally-built ships in the last war. (Reuters).



NO FERRY FOR LAMU

The Hon. Member for Western Area (Mr. E. Kaimosi) is Government aware of the fact that owing to there being no ferry to transport motor cars and lorries between Mokol and Lamu, visitors to and from Lamu, experience great hardship; and in view of the present situation of these being no steamer service between Mombasa and Lamu is it not highly desirable that road communication between Lamu and Mombasa be improved?

His Government's attention has been drawn to the letter appearing in the East African Standard dated 12th December, 1941 (page 16), in connection with the necessity for having a ferry to Mokol and Lamu, a distance of approximately 200 yards, to link Lamu, the third largest town in Kenya, with the mainland.

Will Government please state when it is proposed to put a ferry at this point?

Is a written reply Government's policy?

In a regard the first part of the question, the Government cannot agree that a ferry service to Lamu from the mainland is justified for the benefit of the few visitors that visit Lamu. Further, there are no motor roads on Lamu Island, where all transport is done by donkeys or head-loads. The road between Mombasa and Mokol has considerably improved in recent years.

As regards the second part of the question it is the negative.

As regards the third part of the question for the reasons explained above the Government does not consider that a ferry is necessary at present and does not propose to provide one.

SUBUKIA FARMERS' DEMAND

Criticism Of Government

At a meeting of the Subukia Farmers' Association held last week the following resolution was passed unanimously—

"This meeting of the Subukia Farmers' Association has noted with intense indignation that Government, in spite of their request to the farming community to make an attempt to combine and staff vital to the war effort, has made no attempt to combine and direct the production of these crops. It feels that it cannot emphasize strongly the necessity for Government immediately to organize the full production of the vital food stuffs required, and it feels that to limit another year and to suggest that it is only possible to organize production by the Government is a gross appreciation by Government of the desperate situation into which the food position of the Colony may degenerate. It calls upon Government to give its attention to the Settlement and Production Board, to demand full authority, subject only to the overriding authority of His Excellency in Council, to direct and direct production in all districts, the order of which food stuffs and other agricultural products are to be grown in each district, and where necessary providing finance for the purchase of seed, fertilizer, and other necessary supplies. It demands that District Production Committees, who should have full authority in their own districts."

UGANDA'S WASTE PAPER: IS IT ANY USE?

(“STANDARD” CORRESPONDENT) Kampala, January 26.

For some time past many residents in Kampala have been wondering whether it would not be possible to collect the waste paper and utilize it either for some war purpose or for re-pulpating in order to save the quantity of paper in use in these children Territories. But there is also a very large amount of “waste paper” of all kinds, including advertisements from homes taking us to busy articles which are cannot import and so which are quite unusable as they have been blank side. And the time comes when even with the strictest economy it is not possible to give up envelope again and it has to be recycled.

We have recently heard a lot about the war for the collection of 100,000 tons of waste paper in England. It is a very interesting thing to see their old letters, banks tearing up old orders and so on, in order to do this work. There is little doubt that, as usual, when called upon for efforts in any particular direction, the British public will probably give the amount of effort of them.

And out here we just have to burn it because we are told that it is of no use. Some of the waste paper is of a very good quality and whatever for waste paper? We seem to have a very large quantity of newspaper which can always be used for many purposes, but for the little scraps of many of our newspapers, which are of no use, extra copies, extra copies of memoranda used on both sides, old account books and invoices, etc., of which there must be quite a large quantity available in any business and official community. It is really a pity that there may be no reducing plant in East Africa which could deal with it and re-issue it as newsprint? Surely it should not be allowed to go up in smoke. It would be interesting to hear expert opinions on this matter, especially in view of the special interest that it brings made at home now. Has anyone any suggestions? Given a lead, we will help.

33 JAPANESE SHIPS TOP DANGER Aircraft Carrier Torpedoed

Further Successes By J.S. Navy

January 25. **THESE** are fresh news of the great success of the J.S. Navy in the Macassar Straits. On Friday and Saturday night, 23 Japanese ships, including six aircraft carriers, were destroyed. The loss of these ships was a heavy blow to the Japanese Navy. It is believed to have sunk the most important enemy vessel yet destroyed in the course of the operations. The ships were either sunk or damaged by sea or air forces. It is clear that this was not an ordinary convoy. It is believed to have been composed of troop-carrying transports escorted by warships and strongly covered by aircraft. It was torpedoed off the coast of Borneo and had only been severely hit before the aircraft carrier Allied communications had located the 10 ships in the strait for certain, five more probably destroyed and 13 damaged. This was all done for the loss of one Dutch torpedo and slight damage to an American destroyer.

In addition, the Japanese lost 10 submarines.

Official Report. News about the aircraft carrier is contained in a Navy department communication from Washington. The United States Navy forces have scored further successes in the Macassar Straits. Heavy Japanese air force destroyers and transports were destroyed. While the Japanese were unable to estimate the total damage, the report stated that the Japanese losses were substantial.

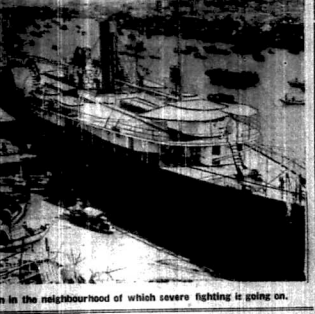

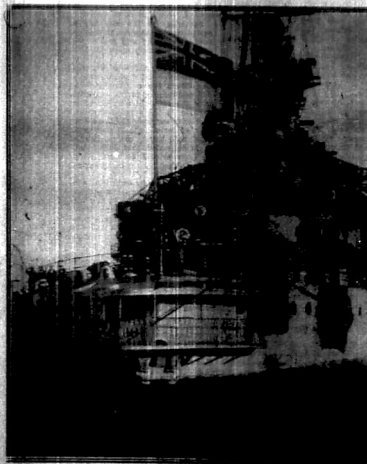
