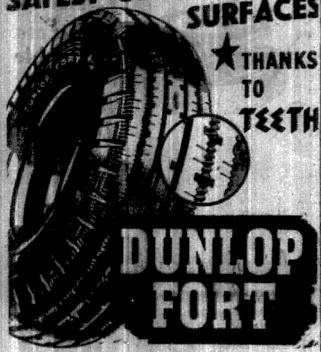

**Gen. Smuts Surveys
Native Problem**

Speaking on "the basis of friendship" at a meeting convened by the Institute of Race Relations in the City Hall, Capetown, on Wednesday night, the Prime Minister, General Smuts, declared that segregation had failed to solve the major problems of the African continent, and offered the concept of "friendship relations between European and African." The great problem in the world today was that of contact between races under fair and decent conditions, and his hope for South Africa was that European and African would work together to build the future of Africa.

Cigarettes for Native Troops
The S.A. Gifts and Comforts Committee have received a further donation of 1,000,000 cigarettes for native and coloured troops in Libya from "One of the Boys Young Things" of Moly Town. These cigarettes have already gone forward.

Pensions After 15 Years?
A suggestion that miners should only be allowed to work on the mine for the stipulated period, after which they should be pensioned off in the same way as civil servants, was made by two witnesses who gave evidence before the Mines' Pensions commission in Johannesburg on Wednesday, Mr. C. J. J. Van der Merwe, presented a memorandum in which he declared that the Mines Pensions Act made no provision for the pensioning of miners, and that provision in the form of a compulsory pension after a certain period, say from 15 to 18 years' service underground, should be made.

Keizer's Plan
A special meeting of the National Party Board of Trustees was held in Capetown on February 9 to consider the effect of the Government's petrol rationing scheme on the future of the Party. Unless some special concession is made by the Government, petrol rationing will probably cripple traffic in the Port. The Board may have to decide on cutting the Party for as long as the petrol rationing scheme remains in operation. It is likely that the Board will decide to make representations to the Government immediately after its meeting and that a public statement will be issued soon afterwards.

British Orders More Boots
South African footwear factories have received a further order for 1,000,000 pairs of army boots for the Imperial Forces. This is in addition to boots and shoes being made for all British troops in South Africa, sea and air forces. The industry will be required to turn out 1,000,000 pairs of boots a month during the year. This figure includes boots for pilots and is expected to meet domestic needs. It is believed that there are sufficient hides in the country to provide the leather required for the boots, which are made almost entirely from South African materials. Various accessories, such as gaiter wire and other fittings are imported, and the main source of supply is Great Britain.

These young people are to be the spearhead of the fight for freedom. "We are young," they declared in their manifestos. "Life with its pleasures is before us. By the strength of our arms, the unity of our purpose and the justice of our cause we will vanquish the enemy of all mankind."

"We fight also for the future. In every land, young people have known economic crises, depression and wars for which they were not responsible. We strive for a social order in which there shall be justice, freedom and security for all, where man is equal to man irrespective of colour, race or creed."

"We will create a world where every nation may freely decide its destiny, where the riches of nature are available to all, and where no man lives in fear. As was reported in the first article previously, the recommendations of the special Commission appointed by the Kenya Government to inquire into the machinery for the conscription of African labour for essential services, the machinery to put the proposals into effect is contained in draft Defence Regulations included in the report and it is proposed in this second article to set out the nature of the machinery to be set on foot to give effect to the conscription plan.

The following is the procedure suggested in the report to obtain the view of conscripted labour or, as the report phrases it, "to obtain most assistance in recruitment."

In the first place, the Defence Regulations provide for the setting up of boards to be called the "Regional Conscription Boards" and they specify carrying on any undertaking which is deemed to be "necessary." The Board may also, from time to time, declare what undertakings in the Colony are, in its opinion, essential to the successful prosecution of the war, the maintenance of supplies and services essential to the life of the community. It has absolute discretion to do so.

When the Governor may establish any local board in any district in the Colony. The chairman will be the District Commissioner and he will appoint the members, but one member may be selected to represent employers and one to represent employees. The function of a District Labour Committee will be to advise the Director of Labour on any matter relating to the conscription of African labour in the district.

Anyone whose application for assistance in recruiting labour has been refused in whole or in part by his Provincial Labour Committee or by a Provincial Commission, may appeal against such refusal to the Director of Labour, who may be final and conclusive. For the purpose of carrying out the functions under these regulations the Director of Labour may co-opt such persons as he thinks fit.

What happens to an approved application is as follows:—When the Provincial Commission is satisfied that the supply of labour of a type suitable for the specified undertaking is available in his province, he orders a District Labour Committee to be set up in that province. On receipt of a number of natives as are specified in the order, but should the Provincial Commissioner, on receipt of the list of the natives can be obtained in his own province, he must forward the application to the Chief Native Commissioner. On receipt of the list of the natives, or any other Provincial Commissioner, to make arrangements to recruit.

When we come to the actual recruiting, the following is the procedure which the Committee suggests should be adopted in the recruitment of natives.

Selection Committee
The first thing is that the District Commissioner of a district in which natives are to be recruited shall appoint what is called a Provincial Selection Committee in each of his districts. Such committee shall consist of not less than six members. If a Local Native Council and/or a Native Tribunal exercises jurisdiction within any such area, not less than two members of the Provincial Selection Committee shall be chosen from the Local Native Council and/or the Native Tribunal.

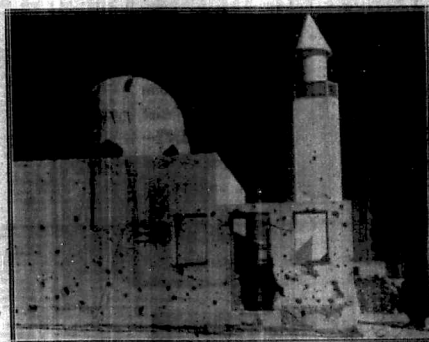

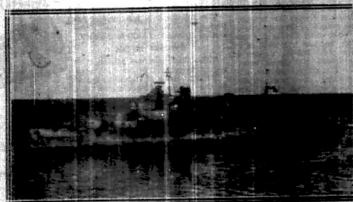

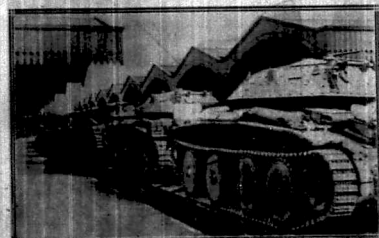

The following is the process now in operation in the selection of conscripts for the use of Government labour. The first stage is the selection of a list of names to be called up for service. This list is prepared by the Director of Labour, who has to take into account the needs of the Government and the needs of the community. The list is then sent to the Director of Conscription, who has to select the names to be called up for service. The names are then called up for service and are sent to the Director of Labour, who has to assign them to work on Government projects.

Representation on Committee

This is the first step. The Governor may establish in any Province a District Labour Committee. The chairman of the District Labour Committee will be the District Commissioner and he will be assisted by two members. One of these members must be selected to represent employers and one to represent employees. The function of a District Labour Committee will be to advise the Director of Labour on matters relating to the recruitment of labour for Government projects. The committee will also be responsible for the selection of names to be called up for service. The names are then sent to the Director of Labour, who has to assign them to work on Government projects.

At any time a conscripted African who is undertaking and requires government labour may apply to the District Labour Committee for a transfer to other work. The committee will consider the application and if it is satisfied that the conscripted African is capable of doing the work, it will recommend that he be transferred to that work. The Director of Labour will then issue the necessary orders for the transfer.

Right of Appeal

Anyone in recruiting labour has to apply to the District Labour Committee for a permit to recruit. The committee will consider the application and if it is satisfied that the applicant is capable of doing the work, it will issue a permit. Procedure in Objections

Having received his notice, the conscripted African may object to the selection of his name. He may do this by applying to the Selection Committee. The committee will consider the objection and if it is satisfied that the conscripted African is capable of doing the work, it will recommend that his name be removed from the list. The Director of Labour will then issue the necessary orders for the removal of the name from the list.

Not Largely Involved

The committee record view that the weight of evidence received indicates that if these proposals for conscription are put on the Statute Book it will not be necessary to involve them to any considerable extent in the period when the government recruitment is in progress.
