Empire, nor are the British people the only group who want the sense of direction to be dissipated and replaced by a clear, clean, Spartan spirit. To this is largely a matter of the spirit. When Sir Stafford Cripps calls for austerity he is calling for something spiritual and psychological; not merely blind faith but a dedication of self, without hysteria, to the justifying that faith.

But, as yet, larger areas of the Empire have not been touched sufficiently deeply by the crisis. Australia has had to begin the task of organising total war, throwing all else aside. Canada, now threatened too, has already made a magnificent contribution. South Africa, in the face of many internal difficulties, has also played a man's part. India, whose millions are by no means fully prepared for total war, is about to come face to face with the crucial test. From all these great Dominions, from many parts of the Colonial Empire, fighting men are going out and women too, and they have proved their worth. But behind them are the great civilian resources. They have yet to learn what war may mean. They have yet to understand how important to Victory is their attitude, their spirit.

The vast resources of the Empire, the great moral resources in particular, are unexploited. It is not only the steel mills, the shipyards, the coal mines, the oil refineries that are being mobilized, it is the human resources that are being mobilized.

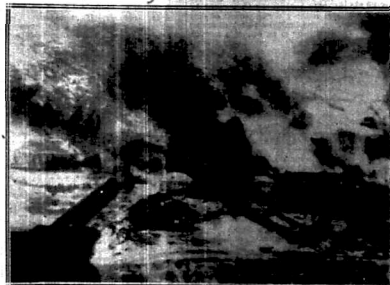

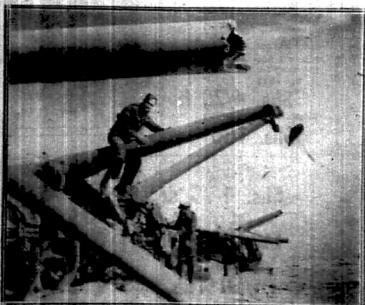

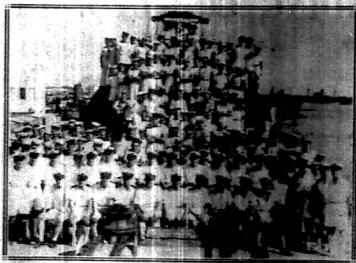
