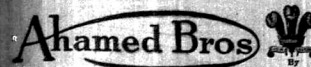

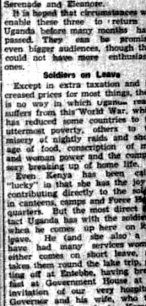

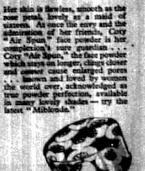

Grant's Whisky

Supplies of many building materials are becoming increasingly difficult. This is particularly true of roofing materials owing to the virtual disappearance of corrugated iron. Roofing tiles of local manufacture therefore assume great importance. There is also being made a market for roofing tiles which can be manufactured by hand.

The East African Industries Technical Advisory Committee has organised a research scheme which will design and produce tiles, slates and firing properties, with particular reference to their suitability for the local climate. Difficulties have up to the present prevented such progress. This project, which will be a considerable time before the Committee's programme, but it is hoped that these difficulties have now been overcome.

Report to Manufacturers

The Committee is, of course, aware that roofing tiles are being made in East Africa and have been made in the past. It is anxious to get in touch with the manufacturers, to learn the types of tiles produced and the quantities. It would like to learn names of potential manufacturers, particularly those having experience in manufacture, and to learn of the existence of processes in operation. It is requested that all those who are interested will communicate with the Secretary, before March 31.

A message from R.A.F. Headquarters, Middle East, received through Air Headquarters, East Africa, on Saturday, a copy of a report prepared by a young pilot from New Zealand (R.A.F. 21987) P/O M. R. B. Smith, T.M.I. for the rescue of a pilot of the Western Desert, in the darkness, to effect the rescue of his crew after his bomber had been forced to land in the desert on a very dark night. When they were coming down the desert, the crew was to be rescued on the floor of the aircraft, and to hold tight as the plane forced landing on rough ground that he could not even see. Two of the crew were killed in the crash but none of the crew were seriously injured although the pilot was hurt. He tried at once to extricate the top engine trapped in the aircraft, not knowing that they were dead but had to concentrate on his own safety and concentrate on saving the rest of the crew.

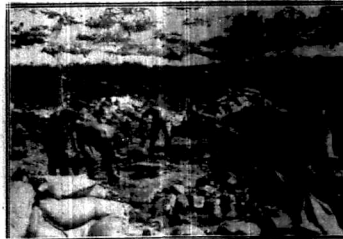

Further South there are shorter and easier tracks from the Arakan coast into the valley of the Salween. But the use of these would depend on sea transport across the Bay of Bengal. At present Arakanese ports such as Akyab, which is held by the British, are under the control of the Japanese. It seems probable that the Japanese will now concentrate upon these ports and will attempt to capture the British and Chinese bases of Lashio in the North.
