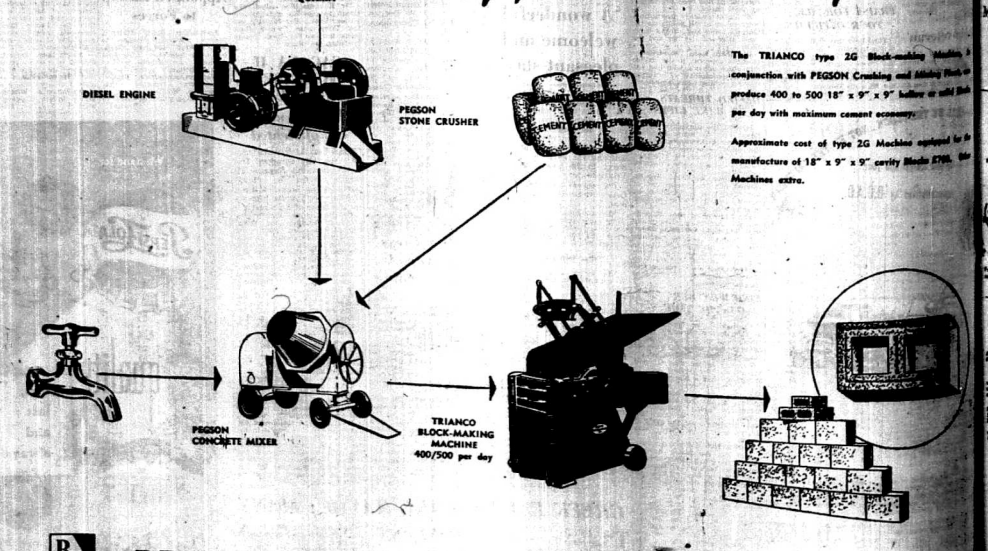

## STATES TO CEASE-FIRE Geneva agreement on Indo-China

### SIR WINSTON SUMMONS SPECIAL CABINET

AGREEMENT on an Indo-China cease-fire has been reached. The negotiations were conducted by France, representing the Western Powers, and by Russia acting on behalf of the Communists.

It has been agreed that the Big Four, China, the three associated States of Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia and the Vietnamese rebels should attend. If the nine delegations wish to invite other interested States, they can do so by unanimous agreement.

This progress was announced after a meeting between Mr. Jean Chauvel, the French Ambassador at Bern and a member of the French delegation to the conference, and Mr. Gromyko, Soviet Deputy Foreign Minister. They decided that the West would invite the three associated States and the Communists Vietnam.

In London, Sir Winston Churchill called a Cabinet meeting for last night to discuss the Geneva Conference and Indo-China. Fresh reports were received yesterday from Mr. Eden, the Foreign Secretary, who is leading the British delegation at Geneva.

It was also agreed that the Big Four, China, the three associated States of Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia and the Vietnamese rebels should attend. If the nine delegations wish to invite other interested States, they can do so by unanimous agreement.

**END FEARS**  
British, France and the United States are understood to be in agreement that the Communists have agreed to the participation of Burma, India and possibly Laos and Indonesia. The three Powers should be satisfied as East-West relations have been improved. The British Government has been determined to resist any Communist move to give China that status.

Western observers said that they expected the peace talks to begin before the end of the week. But it would be some time before the French, British and American delegations from Indo-China, Mr. Nguyen Quoc Dinh, and the Communist delegation from Hanoi, Mr. Phan Van Kien, would agree to take part in the Geneva Conference with the Vietnamese rebels.

**NO RECOGNITION OF REBEL REGIME**  
Mr. D. Dink said that Vietnam's agreement to Vietnam rebels is not a direct or indirect recognition of the rebel regime. He said that the United States would not subscribe to such a declaration.

# DAR ES SALAAM PORT WORK PROGRESS

**£3,750,000 project**

MARKED progress is being made in the construction of Dar es Salaam's new deep-water berths, part of the £3,750,000 project which will enable the port to handle 500,000 additional tons of cargo annually.

It is expected that the whole new port area will be ready to come into operation early in 1956. The contractor's programme alone—the construction of the three berths and the north-side sheds—will be completing the work in October of next year.

The widening of rail facilities and the many other ancillaries are being completed as closely as possible to the completion of the berths themselves, but the installation of 20 cranes and the 1,000 ft. open road expected to be finished before December next year.

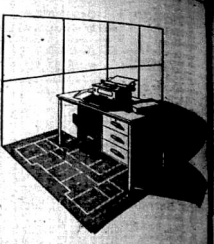

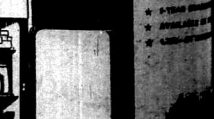

## DRESSED - IN A HANDKERCHIEF!

**DOES it sound odd to dress in a handkerchief—or a number of handkerchiefs?**

If so, I can assure you that Barbara Hux, who will soon be seen in Universal-International's film *Manufacturers' Orders*, knows more than one way of dressing handkerchiefs to day's summer fashions.

Recently, Barbara raffled an impressive array and bought a number of them. They were men's cotton handkerchiefs and a variety of fabrics. She stitched two handkerchiefs together and easily got round the problem of neat fitting by threading the sleeves and collar by the way, lined up a third handkerchief—also folded, under the lace trimming.

First, the either corner of one of the wide side strip round your waist, making a firm knot over the back; pull the other half up, and holding each edge forward, tie the ends neatly in front. The flat of the material thus conceals the back.

Do you want a handkerchief to adorn on the beach, in the garden or on some other moments out of doors, here's a "trick" I've never learned on a Paris beach. Take your square and fold it in half corner to corner (not triangular fashion, but forming a wide pleating). Then fold the top edge back to the bottom single thickness at the top half, and fold the top edge over. Turn up on the outer side, leaving the thick part nearest you. Bend right and left, lower corners up so that they meet at the centre top. Start rolling the wide top edge (further away from you) inwards you, until the hat is the right size for your head. Now you roll the smaller you make it.

These ends under the chin, with the folded part forms a Dutch "bonnet" hat. If you have a few large handkerchiefs in the store each one can make an attractive change of "bonnet" for winter with a suit, and since you tie the handkerchiefs on the cross, they give it an elegant figure. Wind the handkerchiefs with a small black ribbon, with as small a bow as possible, clipped out the neck of the hat (the ribbon points) in front of your bodice, and one corner under each arm and in front of the back and neck the front point into your skirt band. The top can be neatly folded into the pleat first laid, forming pretty corners.

Once you get started you can build a gay and imaginative handkerchief wardrobe. (By arrangement with J. Kenney, Newspapers Ltd.)

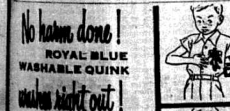

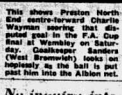
