Too much money has been spent on the construction of Mr. Aitken's new Dyke, the Morogoro Road, according to a present in Tanganyika. ### Tourist trade turning eastward

**R**EPORTS reaching Tangier from World Airlines' Middle East headquarters in Cairo say that airline statisticians were right when they predicted that traffic from Europe and America would surge into the year eastward.

## DCARNO' PACT IN S. E. ASIA PROPOSED

**Mr. Eden suggests basis for peace**

### GENEVA STRENGTHENED ANGLO-CHINESE LINKS

**MR. EDEN** called for a South-East Asia pact to guard against aggression when he opened the one-day foreign affairs debate

in the House of Commons.

He suggested that the pact could run side by side with Treaty of Commerce and the existing Soviet-Chinese, Belgium, France and Italy which promised to attack any other signatory and go to war if any invaded.

The Foreign Secretary said there was no doubt that one in Anglo-Chinese Conference had been an important first step of benefit already to Britain and friendly contacts had been established with all countries concerned—this will be still our aim.

It has been suggested that in negotiating with the Communists we are in danger of weakening our position, but I do not believe that the Chinese have been cheered by both sides of the House. We must continue to make our contribution to peace, by so doing we can earn the confidence of the world.

MR. HERBERT MORRISON, a former Socialist, Foreign Minister, spoke up for the Opposition, said Mr. Eden's

review of the Geneva Conference had been "well-reasoned" and expressed hope that the two sides would be taken in offer.

He said that it did not follow that we should not continue to work with them with a view to improving our relations.

## RAIL STRIKE WARNING FOR THE FUTURE

**NORTHERN RHODESIAN** emerged from the illegal strike of firemen on the Rhodesian Railways last year with a back-and-a-winter country—looking back over the events of the strike, it is clear that the men have shown a remarkable sense of amazement and forward to the industrial future with optimism and enthusiasm.

In simplest terms, the strike was called by the Rhodesian Railways because of a pay increase. It was called because the Rhodesian Railways Union, one of the two unions in Central Africa, did not want to accept the most pliant warning by the Government of both Northern and

The strike, though widely supported as being the only course available, was directly aimed at the welfare of the members, especially those in the Rhodesian Railways Union, who caused both Governments to

rely upon their own security arrangements and the existing systems for maintaining law and order.

At the moment, the incident has ended with the breakdown of the strike and with the return of Mr. Taylor and his staff to work. It is now up to Mr. Taylor to decide what is to be done next.

Within the circle of fascinated entomologists, from the skull of a mosquito to the wings of a fly, there is a wealth of knowledge that would bring many benefits to man.

Mr. Pinhey has done similar work with insect pests. East Africa has been fortunate in that he has made valuable contributions to the control of the tsetse fly. The work has been carried out with other entomologists throughout the world. Dr. G. W. 
