

Lighter growth for Kenya

A drop in the annual rate of growth of Kenya's economy with that of last year, there was reason to be confident that growth would continue to grow satisfactorily, the Minister for Planning and Development, Mr. Mboya, said yesterday.

He was speaking at a Forum organized in Nairobi where he gave one of his regular reviews of the state of the economy in the light of the latest Quarterly Economic Report published by his Ministry.

It was now confirmed that the growth rate for 1967 was likely to be between 4 and 5 per cent, as against last year's record 10 per cent.

Diversification 'vital'

While I would naturally have liked to see the economy moving ahead faster, I do not regard this slight drop as a setback—the important thing is that the overall plan target over a period of years should be realized and it is an accident that this should be attained," Mr. Mboya said.

Much of the slowing-down was due to the position of agriculture and the adoption of new cash crops with a preference to traditional ones.

He appealed for more co-operation between the Government and growers in order to bring their output into line with more intensive use of fertilizers.

He said that the Government was now trying to get more people engaged in agriculture, which would give growing and marketing services on which to base their business.

People's deterioration in the rural balance of trade, the Government was aware of the danger of Kenya slipping into a recession, which might have serious effects on the whole range of investment opportunities in industry, housing, education and other fields.

The Government would like to see a more diversified economy, which would give more opportunities for export earnings, which would help to pay for the balance of trade.

The Minister said that the time had come for a revision of the Government's development policy, which would take into account the new world situation and the need to improve the domestic economy. This would be done by expanding the role of the State in the economy and by making more use of the State's resources.

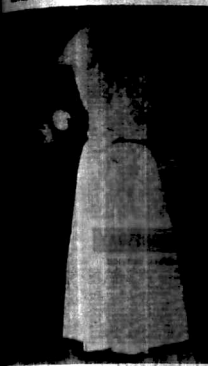

Steady expansion in trade relations all over the world

By the Federal Minister of Economics

Dr. KARL SCHILLER

THE Federal Republic of Germany maintains good and widespread trade relations with nearly all the nations of the world. The basis of this commerce is a steadily expanding exchange of goods and services, advantageous to all.

The extent of these relations, and their significance in the overall economy of the Federal Republic, becomes especially evident in the share which foreign trade has in the Gross National Product.

With a volume of DM 478 billion in 1966, imports at DM 21 billion amounted for 18.2 per cent of the G.N.P., while 14.8 per cent or DM 11 billion of the German G.N.P. crossed the borders of the Federal Republic of Germany in the form of exports of goods and services.

More than three-quarters of the annual imports are goods imports, while the services which foreign countries supply to the German economy come to not quite one quarter.

Nois filled

The goods imported are in the main the products of the food industry which fill existing voids, raw materials, semi- and industrial and products, which Germany increasingly needs for its production. Finally, steadily more consumer goods are being imported, the growing rates of which are the result of increasing prosperity in the Federal Republic.

As for exports, it is worth noting all the branches of the German economy share, the Federal Republic registers more than five-fourths of its goods, and somewhat less than one fifth from that of services. Most goods exports (85 per cent) involve industrial and produce, with machinery, road vehicles, chemical and electrical products constituting the main share.

With these wide-ranging trade relations, the Federal Republic of Germany has developed into the second greatest trading nation, and the third largest industrial nation. The production of German industry, and the level of the German foreign trade are largely the result of the liberal trade policies systematically pursued by the Federal Government.

Above that a world economy free of trade restrictions serves all concerned the best, the Federal Government has repeatedly supported efforts aimed at the creation of a freer world market, be it in OECD, GATT or in the World Trade Conference.

Open market

Thus, it has established a field of activity free from government intervention for Germany's foreign trade, at the same time opened the German market to goods from all the world. It is especially in the services and other branches of trade that the importation of services from abroad exists to the benefit of the Federal Republic.

The foreign trade relations of the Federal Republic, however, are not determined by its trade in goods and services alone; money and capital

transactions are also very important. The German Government encourages its citizens to invest German capital abroad, and by the same token, attracts foreign capital, since it is considered that the free flow of money and capital is an indispensable part of a free world economy in which no nation does what it does best.

Over since the establishment of monetary parity on December 18, 1955, German foreign trade transactions have been free of government direction.

Growing trade

Able from the highly developed political exchange with the industrial nations, the Federal Republic of Germany is also engaged in a constant growing trade with the developing countries. It is gratifying to observe that these countries' trading relations are making ever greater use of the chances offered them by the large German market with its 80,000,000 people.

For five years now, the developing countries have, despite growing German export registered steady trade surpluses, during 1966 their total exchange surplus rose to DM 1,000 million. This is a very important counterpart of Germany's trade relations with the developing countries.

In development, since 1950 and December 31, 1966, the Federal Republic has granted the developing countries 18,000,000,000 DM in public, and 12,000,000,000 DM in private development aid.

In the future, too, also in the limits of her abilities, to make her contribution to the economic development of these nations.

IMPORTS FROM AFRICA MAY RISE

THAT Federal Germany is deeply interested in promoting African exports was demonstrated in a practical manner at an annual "Partners for Progress" import exhibition attended by 18 countries from Africa, Asia and Latin America. It enabled the 14 African participants to lay the groundwork for a step-by-step accomplishment of satisfactory trade partnership with the Federal Republic of Germany, including West Berlin.

Including the nine French-speaking African nations, the other African countries represented at the exhibition were Ethiopia, Kenya, Somalia, Tanzania and Uganda. It is significant to note that the "Partners for Progress" participants from the African continent can be said to be initially acquainted with its functioning — a connection which shows to what extent Federal Germany is keen on serving the export trade needs of the region.

It is obvious that these African nations, which have gained valuable experience and have developed trade links, are keen to make use of the opportunities offered by the "Partners for Progress" exhibition to expand their exports to Federal Germany.

Commenting moves

At the same time, official and private German economic circles and the import trade organizations made moves for cementing binding relations with them so as to help them in organizing an export drive not only in products already on the German market but in other goods which have yet to be introduced.

By laying emphasis on their participation, the German side provided the required incentive for the African countries to fit into the modern marketing methods the more profitable export earnings of the African nations' export drive.

Federal Germany is quite aware that all facilities should

be granted them to help them increase production so that they can increase their incomes and thereby improve their national economic development.

Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda, because of their serious participation at the exhibition, are being approached to be made to support their export trade while Somalia and Uganda are carrying on with the process of investigation and are held in talks with German business circles on an export drive.

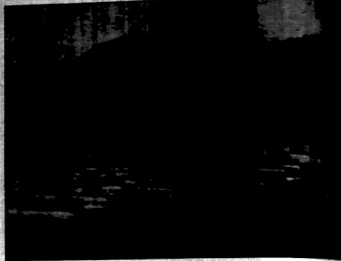
The latest restriction policy of the Federal Republic of Germany is unlikely to stand in the way of their trade relations with Federal Germany, steps for "Progress" exhibition as a springboard for export promotion.

In 1962 the African participation was especially in the nature of a ground-breaking exhibition. It was held in a friendly atmosphere and endeavored to guarantee conditions for cementing their exports.

The exhibition staff officials contacted German traders to discuss in detail the possibility of finding a market for their products. They issued particular interest in their coffee and mango, and endeavored to establish their branch office in Berlin.

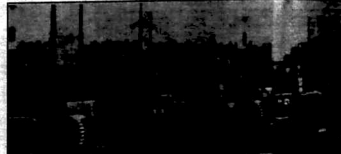
EXPOS MUST PAY FOR IMPORTS

The Federal Republic of Germany must earn foreign currencies to pay for imports worth more than DM10,000,000 every year. Apart from that, industry has virtually no other home-produced raw materials at its disposal. They must be imported. In spite of intensive agriculture, the Federal Republic must also import about 30 per cent of its foodstuff. On the other hand the Federal Republic accounts for 9.5 per cent of total world export trade. Employment security can be guaranteed only by exports in many industrial concerns. In the Volkswagen works, export cars, export trucks, export people work for the domestic market, while 60,000 are engaged on export work.

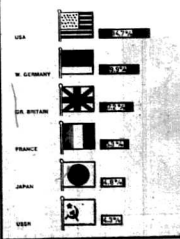

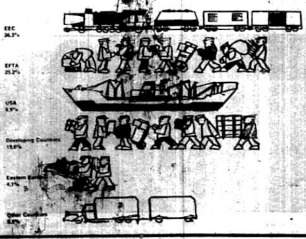

Technical aid given in material form

SINCE 1898 the Federal Government in Bonn has been implementing a many-sided technical aid programme. Its principle help is given not in the form of money but only in personal and material services.

The fundamental concern of this programme is to stimulate the developing countries themselves. For this reason the agreements concluded with them are always based on the principle of reciprocal obligations.

The Federal Republic supplies technical equipment for specific projects such as machinery, tools, instructional materials and so on. It also sends out instructors, usually for two to five years. Part of the instruction given after their return is in vocational schools and factories in Germany.

The form and extent of the technical aid programme depends on the type of project and the local economic and technical conditions.
