# Mr. KOSYGIN AS 'HONEST BROKER'

## U.S. moves to 'break' Tashkent deadlock

Russian Prime Minister, Mr. Kosygin, yesterday took on the role of "honest broker" in an attempt to overcome procedural difficulties holding up discussions between the Indian and Pakistani leaders meeting in Tashkent.

Mr. Kosygin met both the Indian Prime Minister, Mr. Nehru, and President Ayub Khan of Pakistan separately in his efforts to iron out problems over the agenda.

The talks between the two leaders were reported to have been deadlocked since the opening three days ago and both sides were held not being conciliatory.

Mr. Kosygin was reported both trying to persuade both sides to agree to talk about Kashmir in one form or another. Informed sources said Tashkent had stalled earlier, against Indian objections, on having a firm agenda, including the Kashmir problem.

The Russian leader's meeting in the morning with President Ayub Khan lasted nearly three hours, about two hours longer than planned.

# Mr. N. P. Mitton

THE news of the death of Mr. N. P. Mitton in a car accident has been a shock to his many friends and admirers. Mr. Mitton was born in West Dromochry in 1910 and as a young man he had an abiding interest in the technician connected with the preservation and display of natural history objects.

He was trained as a land-surveyor and became a member of the Institution of Surveyors in 1935. He was also known for his services in the service to the East Africa Survey and to the East Africa Survey which was active in many parts of the East Africa Survey after 1942. Mr. Mitton served as a surveyor in the Middle East.

He was appointed as the first and only to return to his native East Africa in 1949 by an offer of a post on the staff of the Technical Museum by Dr. L. S. Leakey, for the purpose of supervising the preparation and display of all collection material.

The link of preparing new exhibits for the herbarium was clearly his forte and he was given complete charge of the work. He was in charge of the preparation and display of all collection material. Mr. Mitton was the enthusiastic challenge of reorganising the entire Museum with hand work and with an excellent grasp of technical problems. His work was done by day, night, a general and complete knowledge of all the matters of the Museum in Africa and a deep interest in the life-life work of his late wife. He was not one to rest on his laurels. He was never satisfied with his achievements and he was always experimenting with his satisfying display methods. His untiring energy and untiring efforts secured him universal respect and popularity, and his untiring efforts will be a great personal loss to his many friends and to the whole community.

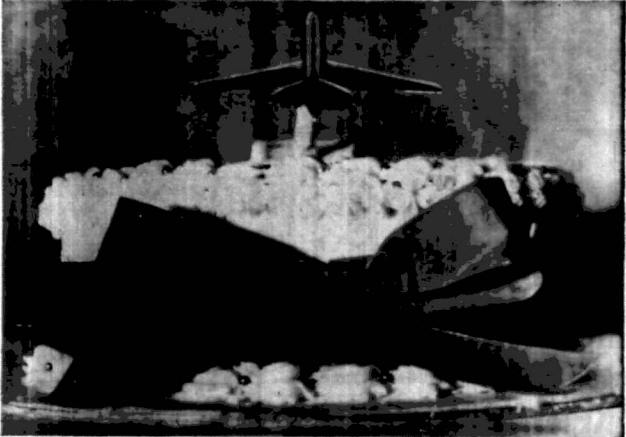

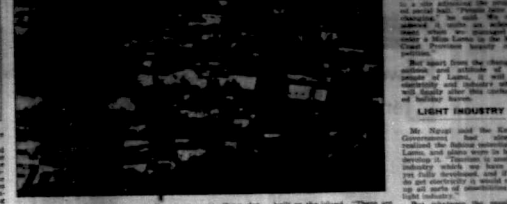

LAMU, the island off the north-east coast of Kenya, which has remained almost unchangeable for hundreds of years, is slowly coming under the influence of the remainder of Kenya — and many of the residents are not sure that it is a good thing.

Recently the East African Company and the Lamu Company have completed a survey of the island, and the knowledge of Lamu, and although it has not yet been decided whether a main supply will be connected to the island, some of the residents are already beginning to think in terms of electric cables, telegrams and even television.

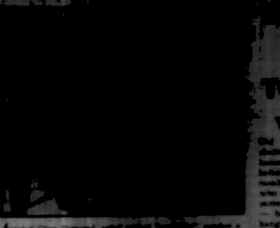

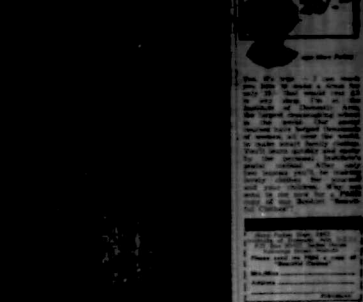

# SANCTIONS WILL WEAKEN — Mr. WILSON

## Confidence reported to Kenya President

He said that the British Government would continue to apply the sanctions until such time as the Rhodesians were ready to accept the terms of the settlement.

ON many main-street pavements in Nairobi sit the beggars, some of them hideously deformed and crippled. Most of them probably started life that way and there is nothing they are lucky. And that is their life; nothing more. It is the only destiny a cripple in Kenya of a few years ago could look forward to.

Today that has changed. Of course there are those who obviously prefer to take the security many way out and turn to the streets for a livelihood. There are others, equally unfortunates, who determined that there will be a job of work in other occupations where they can make a good living for a good day.

There are still people for whom the Association for the Physically Disabled of Kenya is doing a most important job. For them the Association is the hand that holds them up. When the Association was formed in 1962 its primary aim was to help the many adult cripples in Kenya, but later it became apparent that something must be done for children of poorer parents who were not getting a chance to be properly trained and educated. Some special problem and we have always felt that the early treatment of the children is a most important task and will

in their absence the future of which is uncertain. The Association may in 1962 a pilot scheme for the rehabilitation of physically handicapped children was started in Nairobi. From a modest start in two rooms allocated by the City Council, at the Nairobi Baptist Ministry and Child Welfare Clinic, where a group of voluntary helpers provided what care and treatment they could, the Children's Orthopedic Clinic has grown to a size where it is treating nearly 300 cripples waiting lists at the doctor's own experimental projects had grown to such degree that it was obvious that the clinic had outgrown its facilities that could no longer be run as a purely voluntary operation. 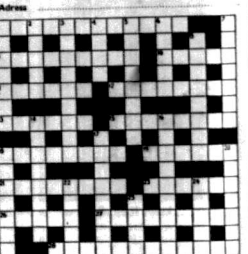
