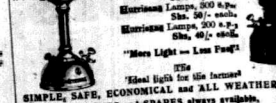

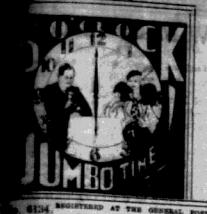

CHRISTIANITY AND WORLD CONDITIONS

To the Editor, "E.A. Standard": It means there is a real danger of falling into error, because we do not fully realize the meaning of events nor see the causes that lie behind them. I have devoted a good deal of thought and reading to the subjects which exercise you and must choose between that and chaos. It has, before being pointed out, been treated as an exception if, as a pastor, we have adopted a course which necessarily leads, either to Communism and thence to Nazism. It is the defender of these qualities that gives the bed-fellows for subversive articles. And now who can say whether we have the National Service and the lack of cohesion for fear in case of attack, or whether we will fall prey to the devil and in frenzy. Ford may delay the evil day and the stamp out or drive subversive forces under ground, for a time only, but in many countries it does not mean that we can expect it to last.

Humanism, Bolshevism which Germany herself helped to evoke. That, I take it, is the story of Hitlerism. Fascism, too, with time, attained more stability but it cannot say its origin was really the same. The error lies in fancying that anyone can realistically say what has behind the movements of these times; or that forceful control, in any form, can be the means of satisfactorily defeating whatever militates against the world's peace of mind. Communism, the sufficing domination of the sands and bodies of human government are tending, in truth, the elimination of the great anti-Christ and the only means to counteract this effectively is by the purification of Christian truth, the Christian spirit. Not formalism, velleed paganism, but the earnest, the fervent, the spiritual, which we as a race have prided ourselves on—shrilly honesty, patriotism, sportsman's hip, practicality, loyalty—would bring us nearer to the solution of our troubles than all the vapourings of communism.

It is the defender of these qualities that gives the bed-fellows for subversive articles. And now who can say whether we have the National Service and the lack of cohesion for fear in case of attack, or whether we will fall prey to the devil and in frenzy. Ford may delay the evil day and the stamp out or drive subversive forces under ground, for a time only, but in many countries it does not mean that we can expect it to last.

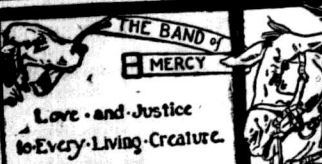

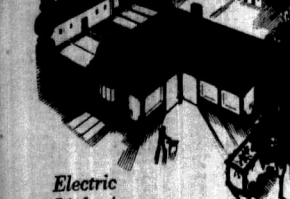

AIR CRUISES.

Seven Day Trips From London to Cairo.

(By Air Mail.)

Cruises in the air are to follow during the week, on a new form of holiday making.

Important Airways have arranged during October to operate special cruises from London, via the Mediterranean to a distance of 2,000 miles, in only seven days. Travellers will leave Croydon Aerodrome on October 10 in the plane of master luxury aircraft "Hibernia", and will fly to Cairo by way of Paris, Marseille, Rome, Malta and the north coast of Africa. Cairo will be reached on October 17 after only three days flying. The return flight to London will be started the following day via Athens, Bradford and Paris, reaching London on Tuesday morning, October 23.

THREE YEARS WITHOUT RAIN.

Terrible Conditions in Lake Rudolf Area.

(From a correspondent.)

Three years ago the last sun fell on the south-east coast of Lake Rudolf, and as a result of this long thought vegetation has almost ceased to exist. Buffets pick green leaves in the scrub forest and are in consequence of this constant charge of dirt, too weak to charge the human intruder. Greater koodoo and other game are slowly dying and the majority of desert water holes are bone dry.

A large bull elephant with long thin tapering tusks gave a first opportunity for photography when he took up charge, involuntarily stuck his tusks into the ground, and at once became bulimic.

While big game animals are dying on land big game fish are being asphyxiated in the Lake, and on an expedition Nile Dutch gave an engine party a good fight recently after being looked, when trailing from a small speed propelled by an motorist.

DRY CONDITIONS AT THIKA.

District Authorities Needing Rain.

(STANDARD'S CORRESPONDENT.)

This, October 11. Very dry conditions prevail throughout Thika district and scorching winds are sweeping throughout. Several grass hives have broken out here and there; a few which were in the Makini swamps were only broken out just as things to leave the pump-house on Capt. Corning's estate a few nights ago.

In some shambas in Upper Thika a fine blossom is tipping on the bushes, only yielding rain to materialize. Other estates show a melancholy picture of dried leaves and drooping bushes.

Native cattle have been driven long distances in search of grazing. But the local Wabukhu appear confident that rain is very close and are projecting their shambas with great activity.

Reverting to the ever-present topic of the morning rains, most latecomers to wireless are becoming accustomed to the monotonous "No rain has fallen at Nairobi, Mombasa, Kisumu and Helms"—or some such slogan. Reports of rain at Nairobi or elsewhere are as infrequent as the dry coffee area, and we do not all know when we get it at Thika.

But may it be suggested to the Meteorologist that he give us the direction of the wind from Zanzibar and Broken Hill, from whence dials come our officers?

JUDICIAL APPOINTMENT.

Uganda Magistrate for Gambia.

The appointment is announced of Mr. John Milton Grey, Magistrate in the Uganda Judicial Department, to be Judge of the Supreme Court in Gambia.

Mr. Grey, after leaving King's College, Cambridge, in 1911, was ordered to a firm of solicitors but both here and on the outbreak of war served with the forces until 1920, retaining his rank of captain. He then joined the Uganda Service on the Uganda Judicial Commissioner and was appointed a Magistrate in the Judicial Department in 1924.

Mr. Grey acted as Solicitor-General in a short period in 1930, and is presently acting as Pleas Clerk in the chamber of Mr. Justice O. E. B. He was called to the Bar in 1929.

Appointment of New Chief Secretary.

The Secretary of State for the Colonies has selected Mr. Samuel Sheridan Lloyd McElharry, B.A., Zanzibar Chief Secretary, Tanganyika Territory, for the appointment of Chief Secretary, Zanzibar, in succession to Hon. R. H. Cotton, who possesses an honours degree in 1912.

Mr. McElharry, entered the Colonial Service in 1924. In 1925 he was in the Audit Department of Hong Kong, and for periods in 1927 and subsequent years was Acting Assistant Chief Secretary and Clerk of Council. He became Assistant Chief Secretary at Zanzibar in 1929, and held the acting appointment of the superior rank on several occasions. From December 1929 to March 1930 he was Acting Secretary, Administration, Tanganyika Territory. Returning to Zanzibar in the latter year, Mr. McElharry was Acting Treasurer, and he has been Acting British Resident on several occasions.

Mr. Cotton, B.A. of Oxford, was a Helms Scholar. He studied for the law, becoming a barrister-at-law. He was in the 10th Hussars two years previously but had refused the services of the Zanzibar Protectorate as Assistant Collector.
