World Bank net income increases

THE International Bank for Reconstruction and Development reported its net income of \$20,000,000 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1939.

The amount was \$2,000,000 more than the \$18,000,000 net income reported for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1938.

The net income was made up of the Bank's operations in the various countries and its interest on loans and guarantees and raised the reserve to \$97,000,000.

The Bank's assets, amounted to \$120,000,000 and were credited to the special reserve, increasing that reserve to \$49,000,000.

Bond Issues

During the year the Bank issued \$100,000,000 of bonds in the United States. It has also issued \$100,000,000 of bonds in Europe. The total of \$200,000,000 of bonds issued during the year is the largest amount in the history of the Bank.





10,000 TROOPS MASSES IN SETTLEMENT

INDIA has accepted Portugal's proposal for impartial observers to report on the situation in the Portuguese Possessions in India. This was announced yesterday in New Delhi.

A Note handed to the Portuguese Minister in New Delhi asked that representatives be appointed immediately to discuss ways and means with India.

Portuguese proposals, as it was ascertained, are as free as those in the Union and determined by him being anxious to find solutions by conference and negotiation.

It is disclosed in Lisbon that the nations had expressed agreement with the Portuguese proposal, announced by the Foreign Minister, Dr. Paulo Cunha, and reported supporting the suggestions are Britain, Italy, Belgium, Spain, Brazil and Chile.

According to reports from Bombay, 10,000 troops have been concentrated in Goa and another 2000 Portuguese within 24 hours of Indians without residence permits authorized in the settlement.

Several Indian labourers are affected.

A British Foreign Office spokesman said in London that the Government was glad to see the Indian declaration that it was determined to pursue a peaceful and conciliatory approach towards the situation in Portuguese India. He was commenting on the Indian reply to the Portuguese proposal that should be "frankly from a neutral point of view."

Delegation of all parties may leave next month

BRITAIN will send a Parliamentary delegation to Moscow next month in response to an invitation from the President of the Supreme Presidium, Marshal Zhukov. The invitation, sent to the Lord Chancellor, Lord Simonds, and the Speaker of the House of Commons, Mr. W. Morrison-Lough, is expected to be made at the end of September or the beginning of October.

Mr. Malenkov dines with Socialists

MR. MALENKOV, Premier of the Soviet Union, dined at the British Embassy in Moscow and discussed world politics with Mr. Attlee and other Labour leaders. It was the first visit of a Soviet Premier to the Embassy since Mr. Stalin conferred with Mr. Churchill during the war.

The dinner at the Embassy was believed to have been arranged personally by Mr. Attlee. Mr. Malenkov, who is 56, is a member of the Politburo and the Central Committee of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union.

Quakers object to wording of S. Rhodesian oath

THE Southern Rhodesian Oath of Allegiance prevents people who believe conscientiously for them to take part in the new constitution. The Quakers submitted to Members of the Federal Parliament in London a petition in which they stated that although the sections dealing with the Oath of Allegiance are not immediately relevant, they are nevertheless relevant to the question of citizenship since before the Federal Parliament.

It points out that under the Southern Rhodesian Citizenship and British Nationality Act of 1948, an applicant for Southern Rhodesian citizenship must take an oath of allegiance.
