COMMUNISTS FIRE ON CHEISO ISLAND

Nationalist jets bomb mainland

U.S. OFFICERS KILLED; WARNING BY MR. DULLES

AS an artillery duel developed across the Nationalist-held island of Quemoy and the Communist mainland yesterday, Nationalist planes attacked Communist batteries with bombs and rockets, it was reported from Taipei, Formosa's capital.

The duel was a resumption of an action lasting five days last week in which Communist troops were killed during the Communist shelling.

Nationalist Thunderjet bombers were reported to have taken part in the action against the mainland, according to the New China (Communist) News Agency, Chinese Communist anti-aircraft units shot down one Nationalist plane and damaged another over the island.

Gen. Chiang Kai-shek called his Service chiefs into an emergency conference to discuss the situation. A Nationalist military spokesman said the attack was the Communist bombardment would "most probably be followed by an attempt to invade the island."

Later, Mr. John Foster Dulles, the American Secretary of State, issued a blunt warning in Manila that U.S. forces would take instant action if the Communists attacked Formosa or the Philippines. "The situation is fraught with peril to the entire area of life in Asia and throughout the world," Mr. Dulles said.

"The United States - Philippine Mutual Defense Treaty is an important link in the defense of the Pacific and is unbreakable," he said.

"We wish to state in the most emphatic terms that the United States will not permit any Communist aggression against Formosa or the Philippines were it followed by an attempt to invade the island."

"The Philippines were attacked by a Communist submarine which was destroyed by the United States Navy and Air Force."

At the end of the session, Mr. Dulles said that the United States would continue to support the Philippines in their fight against Communist aggression.

SEATO TALKS BEGIN TODAY

After Mr. Dulles's address to the United States Foreign Relations Council a communiqué was issued which stated that the Defense Department was giving priority consideration to a joint Navy and Air Force.

At the end of the session, Mr. Dulles said that the United States would continue to support the Philippines in their fight against Communist aggression.

27 MISSING IN PLANE CRASH

Ships search River Shannon

SIX hours after a K.L.M. Royal Dutch airplane crashed into the River Shannon in Ireland yesterday 27 people of the 50 on board were still missing, a company spokesman said at the Hague. He said 23 passengers and seven crew - had been saved and were in hospital but there was no hope of finding any more survivors.

Rescuers believed the missing crew members were still alive. It will not be known for certain until the bodies of the 27 women and seven children, but American and Canadian search parties are still searching the river after the crash.

Imports from Japan in 1955

LICENSING SCHEME FOR KENYA AND UGANDA

SUBJECT to few exceptions, the importation of all types of Japanese goods will be permitted into Kenya and Uganda next year. In making this announcement during the weekend, the Kenya and Uganda Governments stipulate as the exceptions tyres and tubes, singlets, hoisery and underpants, boots and shoes and cement.

Licenses for all goods will be issued with effect from January 1, 1955, but textiles will be permitted to arrive before June 1 next year. The Tanganyika Government announced on August 15 that licenses for imports from Japan into Tanganyika would be issued from January 1 for deliveries to arrive earlier than March 15.

As with the Tanganyika licensing plan, Kenya and Uganda licenses related to their establishment will support from Japan. Licenses will be issued for the first time since 1945. Licenses will be issued for the first time since 1945.

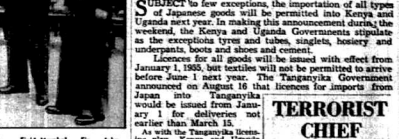

KENYA DECONTROL OF MEAT AND VEGETABLES Increase in prices not expected

HOUSEWIVES ASSURED OF GOOD SUPPLIES

The decontrol of meat and vegetables in Kenya, announced this morning, gives the City's housewives a chance to lower their bills—if they are prepared to buy selectively.

Traders are emphatic that prices will not rise; expect them to fall slightly. The president of Nairobi Greengrocers Association, Mr. M. Z. Malik, said: "Spices are good and when the farmers know their prices are no longer controlled it is likely they will bring in more produce. Prices cannot go up."

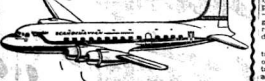

SOUTH-EAST ASIAN DEFENCE PACT SIGNED Signatories to issue 'Pacific Charter' JOINT ACTION AGREED ON COMMON DANGERS

EIGHT nations signed the South-East Asian Treaty at Manila yesterday, promising to stand together against aggression in South-East Asia and the South-West Pacific. They agreed at the same time to issue a declaration of principles to be known as the "Pacific Charter".

The treaty was signed by the United States, France, Great Britain, New Zealand, Pakistan, Thailand and the Philippines, recognizing that an armed attack in the area would endanger their own peace and safety. The eight nations agreed to act to meet the common danger which they had unanimously agreed to designate was attached-and provided the Government of the area which they had included in this category are likely to be the three Indo-China States—Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam—which are covered in a separate Protocol.

The treaty was defined as including the general areas of South-East Asia and South-West Pacific. It also includes the whole territory of any of the "Asian parties", which means that an attack on either East or West Pakistan, any British territory in the area, or any of the other States, Korea and Malaya are included in the treaty.

NEW COUNCIL TO BE CONVENED SOON

Hongkong and Formosa, which are not members of the pact, will be invited to join the new council which will be set up to meet at any time and will be held in Manila. The council will be composed of representatives of the eight signatories and will be responsible for the implementation of the pact. It will also be responsible for the issue of a "Pacific Charter" which will be issued by the council.

Wrongful arrest of magistrate

A FORMER senior magistrate of Johannesburg, Mr. Donald Hector Kirchner, aged 56, was awarded a total of £2,000 costs and damages against the South African Minister of Justice, Mr. Charles Swart and Police Sgt. Mr. Kirchner, who was only 56 years of age at the time of his arrest, said he had suffered great physical and mental distress, and that his reputation as a magistrate and as a citizen had been injured.

SOUTH-EAST ASIAN DEFENCE PACT SIGNED Signatories to issue 'Pacific Charter' JOINT ACTION AGREED ON COMMON DANGERS

EIGHT nations signed the South-East Asian Treaty at Manila yesterday, promising to stand together against aggression in South-East Asia and the South-West Pacific. They agreed at the same time to issue a declaration of principles to be known as the "Pacific Charter".

The treaty, signed by Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Burma, Indonesia, the Philippines and Malaysia, is a landmark in the history of the region. It is the first time that the nations of South-East Asia and the South-West Pacific have agreed to stand together against aggression in their own region.

The treaty also provides for the establishment of a South-East Asian Defence Pact, which will be a permanent body for the purpose of maintaining peace and security in the region.

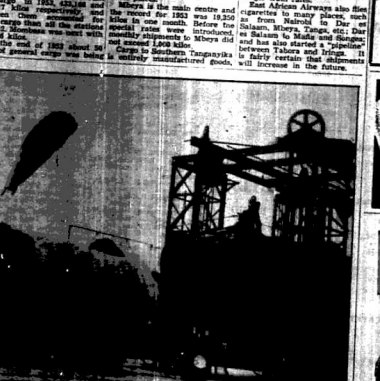

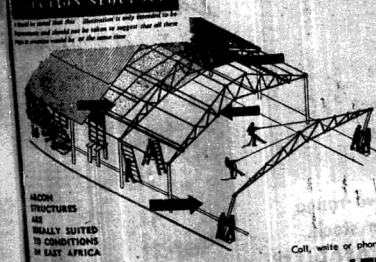

Soldiers to act as guards for farms

FOOD, BONUS SCHEME

The Board of Agriculture has announced details of a new scheme designed to assist farmers who wish to take local leave without leaving their farms unattended. The Board has made arrangements with the military authorities for farmers requiring assistance of this nature to be put in touch with British officers or other ranks who volunteer to act as caretakers while the farmers are away on leave.

These caretakers will be granted leave for periods of up to six months, and will normally act in pairs.

Apply to Army

Although the soldiers will not be allowed more than 14 days leave at a time, farmers wishing to go away for longer periods will be able to arrange with the military authorities for a system of relief parties covering 827 miles within reason.

Farmers wishing to take part of the scheme should contact the central Board of Agriculture or their respective district officers or if they prefer, write to the Director of Agriculture, P.O. Box 4006, Nairobi.

In a statement to the East African Standard yesterday, an official of the Board of Agriculture stressed that farmers need not expect these soldier caretakers to have any farming experience.

Their main function is to take care of the property and stock which would be left unattended in their absence.

Transport need

Farmers who apply for assistance will be told that the guards can be collected and sent to any place where they are required to provide transport or rail fare for their collection and delivery to their farms.

The farmer will be expected also to provide food and accommodation in addition to granting a bonus of 100/- per week to be divided among the guards.

The military authorities have pointed out that they cannot accept any claim for damage done by military animals, nor any arrangements, and farmers will be asked to sign an undertaking to this effect.

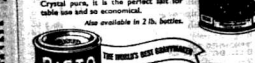

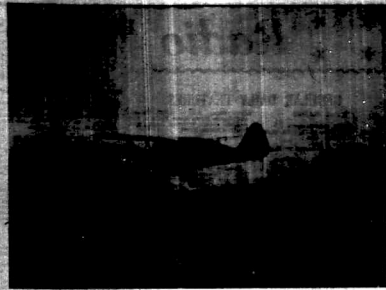
