FIRM MARKS 10th BIRTHDAY BY OPENING NAKURU FACTORY

ONE Nairobi business which prides itself on having expanded considerably since the last Lancaster House conference is White Rose Dry Cleaners, which has just celebrated its 10th anniversary by opening its second factory and 33rd branch at Nakuru.

As well as being a new venture for the firm - it is the first branch to be established outside Nairobi - this provides Nakuru with a new service.

Up till now up-country people have had to rely on articles for dry cleaning to deposit or agents and everything had to be sent to Nairobi for processing.

The business, started by Mr. H. Kenway in 1932, was originally a home delivery and collection service based on the factory. Nairobi's working class made little use of such a service as working hours were not satisfactory, and a year later the first central-town shop was opened.

Mr. Kenway was born in South Africa, where he was engaged in the cinema business before coming to Kenya.

Trained abroad Two of his sons are associated with him in the company. Mr. Len Kenway is the family's technical expert - trained with ICI he has travelled and worked in South Africa, Britain and the United States and last year did a five-month course on techniques and management at the U.S. National Institute of Dry-Cleaning.

Mr. Noel H. V. Kenway is responsible for public relations and marketing. The technical director is Mr. R. H. Brown, who has 12 years' experience in the dry-cleaning industry and joined the firm from Britain soon after it started.

Another ICI-trained technician, Mr. Boston Aherny, is general manager and responsible for the staff training.

The White Rose policy is one of active responsibility, not passivity. The firm has provided regular conducted plant tours for its customers.

They have introduced a number of new services for their customers, including a record-keeping and re-inventing treatment for fabrics and, through an associate company, repairs.

Tours arranged These are published by special introductory offers, which seek to distribute leaflets advertising details of the firm's services and regular conducted plant tours for its customers.

One example of the way in which the company tries to keep up to date and constantly improve its work is that it sends samples to the National Institute of Dry-Cleaning in America for analysis. Many kinds of fabrics are given priority by the American laboratory, especially in Nairobi and Kampala.

Britain fails to save four-year-old link

U.N. FETTERED BY TREATY

But common services will continue

BRITAIN formally admitted yesterday that she has failed to avert the break-up of the West Indies Federation.

The Colonial Secretary, Mr. Maudling, told the House of Commons that there would be legislation soon to dissolve the four-year-old federation.

He regretted that he could not take this step but his visit to the West Indies had disclosed that there was no alternative. His talks with leaders there showed that the situation facing the Government was that:

New link may grow

Jamaica had declared its determination to withdraw from the federation and this decision had been accepted by Britain. The government of Trinidad and Tobago had decided not to take part in any federation of the Eastern Caribbean.

Finally, the Premier of Barbados and the Chief Minister of the Leeward and Windward Islands, who had advocated a new federation between their territories, were not prepared to present one.

Mr. Maudling said that Britain would not be dissolved, interim organization under a British-appointed Commission for running the islands' common services.

Despite Mr. Maudling's last-minute efforts, Jamaica's session has always been widely regarded as a death blow for the federal talks in a fix to save Jamaica's independence — expected to be August — are taking place in Port of Spain, Trinidad.

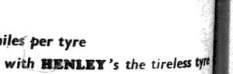

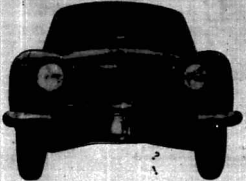

ARLY £2,500,000 will be needed to rehabilitate European and African farms ravaged by drought, army worm and torrential rains.

RESTORING AGRICULTURE

GRABALY, on the weeks past, the full tragedy of the drought, army worm, famine and food shortages in Kenya, and the country began to lick its wounds and reconstruct its shattered economy.

One thought must be paramount at this time. Despite all the aid from the O.R.A. and other agencies, it is still evident that Kenya is still a starving people and that the country is in a very pitiful plight.

By KENNETH MEADOWS, LONDON.

ONE of the first statements made by the President of the Kenya African National Union, Mr. Kenyatta, after he arrived in London yesterday was: "We believe the British Government will be willing to name the date of our independence at the end of this year."

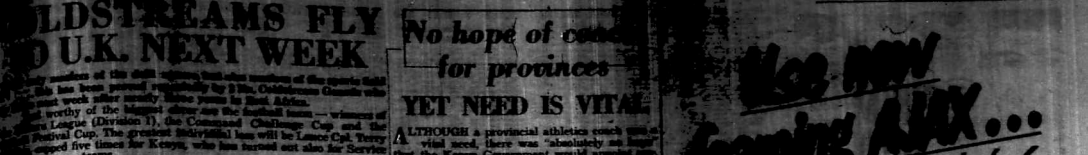

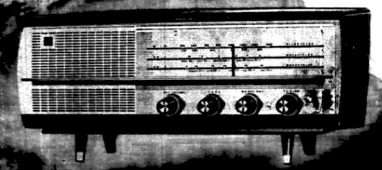
