THE ADMIRAL SCHEER

Further Great Exploits By The Royal Navy

HEAVY GERMAN LOSSES

**THE ADMIRALTY ANNOUNCES THAT THE GERMAN
POCKET BATTLESHIP, ADMIRAL SCHEER, WAS
SUCCESSFULLY ATTACKED BY A BRITISH SUBMARINE ON
THURSDAY MORNING OF LAST WEEK.**

The communiqué reveals that other successes include the sinking of German transport and supply ships. Two large German ships scuttled themselves to avoid capture, a third, of 5,500 tons, was captured and a fourth was sunk by the Norwegians.

German troops are reported to have abandoned Narvik and to have fled into the mountains.

The British Admiralty was able to announce that eight names of the ships captured or sunk by the British. The communiqué does not reveal where the German ships were sunk, but it is clear that many of them relate to the operations in the Skaggerak and Kattegat where so many German transports and supply ships were sunk on Wednesday.

The communiqué also carried out this attack was the Spanish coast, and that the British submarine, which was probably with more than ten torpedoes, was sunk in the war when it escaped from the German destroyer the Heiligland Night after an encounter with the British submarine.

These ships in order to carry the large calibre guns possible had to sacrifice armour in order to give speed and in the case of the Admiral Scheer the armour thickness of the armour is actually lighter than those of the other two.

At night, pocket battleships are the first ships of such a size to have effectively a considerable saving in weight.

Although officially rated as armoured ships they are actually equipped in armoured cruisers of an exceptionally powerful type.

It may be significant that last night the Admiralty announced the publication of a list of casualties of the battle. It will be recalled that the Admiral Scheer was reported to have been sunk on Wednesday and it will be remembered that some of the Admiral's crew were later seen setting off by the shore fully armed on a little expedition.

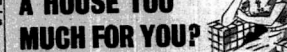

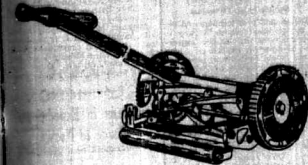

An Offer of Service. Danish and Norwegian residents in East Africa have been prompted to indicate to the public their sympathies lie with the Allied cause.

The Danish and Norwegian communities in East Africa have taken the first step in the disposal of the British Government. A responsibility lies on the shoulders of the authorities to ensure that the offer is employed in wide directions.

Their numbers are in East Africa. Distance from the scene of conflict, and the general overview of the situation, may enforce upon them a period of unswerving and unhesitating action. It is important to arrive at an appreciation of the situation in the common cause that, better informed on details than any hastily convened meeting could be, they will be in a position in the short time to make proposals for the best employment of man-power and material resources in the common cause.

The Danish and Norwegian people, indeed all Scandinavians, are worthy East African subjects. They have long played a leading part in the development of the Territories as law-abiding and industrious people, and within their group a number of whom we are now happily rid, they have never indulged in political movements or in the activities of the Government. Indeed the Scandinavian people have always identified themselves so closely with the land and the people of these East African Dependencies as to become in the best sense good East African citizens.

It was natural that during the war the British community here should be ever ready to stand by British people who are never really intolerant or without understanding, and through the warm regard which we have entertained for the Scandinavian people in our midst was naturally to be met the news of changing conditions in Europe. Now that Denmark and Norway have become victims of aggression, their friendly feelings are intensified and the knowledge that we are fighting in a common cause, against a joint crusade against the forces of evil, brings us together in even closer harmony within the Empire.

The Danes and Norwegians in Eastern Africa can be assured of the comfort of British friendship and sympathy surrounding them in their war and encouragement in these difficult days. And for our part we appreciate and are glad of the following of the splendid spirit of the Danes and the Norwegians and of their trust, now that the war has come to them, in the righteousness of the Allied cause and the certainty of its ultimate success.

It is in that knowledge they can face the dark days that lie ahead with the confidence and the inspiration that comes from the knowledge that they are not alone any longer, and have not been allowed to become another unhelpful sacrifice to the senseless and unheroic war for power. That is all the encouragement we can give them today, because neither the Allied nor the Scandinavian peoples know what the future holds for them. But it is an encouragement, which, means much to all of us in our common cause.

The Danish and Norwegian communities in East Africa have taken the first step in the disposal of the British Government. A responsibility lies on the shoulders of the authorities to ensure that the offer is employed in wide directions.

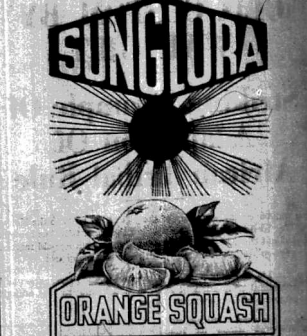
