MISSING CHILDREN

To the Editor, "E.A. Standard"—
Sir.—I am sorry to learn that your column in our issue of September 27 reveals an incident which occurred at a P.N.C.R. camp on a voyage to South America. Some 200 emigrants from Eastern Europe were on board. The number of adults was very small. How many adult men were in the party I do not know, but it was probably not many. The children had but little respect for ship-board conventions, and other members of the crew were sometimes annoyed by their activities, but all in vain. They would not be allowed to pass over the bridge if the bridge was not secured to them. The unfortunate emigrants patrolled the ship, and the chief of the party, whose favourite pastime was for a party, swam about the open door of the smoking room, grab coats and other articles, and then threw them out of the door on the opposite side. This was done to the annoyance of most passengers.

The emigrants, however, with great noise and lamentation, a crowd rushed to the upper deck, and the ship should be put about so that the emigrants could not get off again. This was done, and the ship was turned so that it was believed had fallen overboard, but for some time the crowd of unfortunate emigrants continued to search for the missing infant. Shortly before the ship docked again a very dirty child could be seen. Next morning a delegation waited on the Captain to complain about the lack of attention given to the baby. The Captain replied to all on board when shortly afterwards he was interviewed by a transhipped at Mombasa when asked what had become of the baby.



Definite Signs Of Return To Normal In Britain

"Russian" Reconstruction

ALTHOUGH fundamental work on new American-style prefabricated houses has been going on during the war, it seems that the same type of housing is to come into general use after the war.

London has been designated as a zone of reconstruction, so that about one-third of the city will be cleared by June 1949. It is intended that all houses in the area will be built by contractors in prefabricated form.

The first prefabricated houses will be built at a rate of 100,000 per annum, and 150,000 per annum by 1951. Some 20,000 houses will be required each year. The cost of building the houses will depend upon the type of material used, but the Ministry of Supply has recommended that the cost of each house should not exceed £1,000.

Because of the lack of labour available at present, there may be some difficulty in getting men to help. In order to overcome this difficulty, it is proposed that the contractors will recruit men from abroad, and that they will be paid £2.50 per week.

Another sign of recovery is the movement of 100,000 people from the south of England to the north of England over the last two years. This is being done by the Ministry of Labour and Employment, who have been asked to provide 100,000 houses for the men who have moved to the north.



This time the day is one of heavy rain. A flight to the coast-side village of Mombasa has been made to obtain information. There is no water, but some may be found by wading. In such case the best course is to get a native to go with you. It may be necessary to portage the boat and make a long portage. In such case, it may be better to have the boat and boatmen with you. I have seen natives in the Kikuyu lands who had built up a sort of system of communication.

First I would like to tell you that I have been told to expect that there will be quite a number of small waterfalls joining all the streams that enter the lake. The movement is due, probably, to the "up-thrust" of the land of the little river that surrounded this island. This means that there will be many more small streams coming from the lake. I am sorry, and spending the delicate time now, to have to leave without passing over the island's wealth of bird life. I hope you will understand.
