Right of Freedom

Now we perceive these rights as fundamental principles of freedom supported by the State. In the case of individual freedom to care for one's self, who can contrive other risk who can contrive other risk?



Wool Classing In New Zealand Pays Dividends

From a New Zealand Correspondent.
In New Zealand there have been increases of up to 10 per cent in the value of the wool produced last year. Island wool clips each worth over £1,000 per ton have been graded and these increases are proved to have been due to the improved methods of analysis based on last season's reports.

The owners of two of the clips are combining to form a company which has added a gross value of from £100 to £150 per ton to their clip through their wool having been classed as "prime".

The three clips, all of them Ramer, are now being graded and the range of prices is very limited. The clip in charge of the New Zealand Wool Council follows:—
