Brussels orders reinforcements to be sent from Europe

BELGIANS FREE CONGO IN PANIC

Capital taken over by army mutineers

Five shot dead in Italian riots

ONE THOUSAND Belgian men, women and children fled in terror after the Congo River from Leopoldville early yesterday after the new Congo Republic's capital was taken over by mutineers.

The mutineers, with fixed bayonets and light machine-guns, stopped the ferryboats, took over the cable and telephone offices and the city, stopped emergency calls and were trying to leave, took away all their possessions, then closed them to turn back.

In Brussels the Belgian Cabinet met to consider the panics of troops to reinforce Belgian Army units already there to ensure the evacuation of the European families still in Leopoldville.

The panic flared in Leopoldville soon after midnight as Belgian troops in a camp just outside the capital drove

They held up European-driven cars at gunpoint and broke into homes looking for their former Belgian officers and White women. Officers who were found were arrested and marched off to army barracks. Women in the hundreds of Belgian families stayed in the compound of their embassy where officials provided meals and shelter.

Meanwhile, tired and dirty European refugees continued to stream into Leopoldville from other areas of the week-old republic—including a trainload of 400 from the mutiny town of Thyville. Most of them had stories to tell of violence and rape.

The Belgian Ambassador, Baron Jean van den Bosch, urged that they should all get away as soon as possible. He said he was still surrounded yesterday after the mutineers stopped the ferries to Brazzaville—capital of the former French Congo which is now independent.

Those that got away across the river in time formed long queues that filed slowly past the riverbank where they were being searched for their arms and the women and children were being taken to the mutineers' headquarters for detention.

Stormy meeting

Communications with the Belgian Embassy in Leopoldville yesterday afternoon, when the Belgian ambassador reported the situation there, was very stormy.

The Belgian Foreign Minister, M. Mombombani, said he thought that a group of soldiers had been sent to Leopoldville.

They went to the airport and started on the plane by the stopping cars and buses.

The Congo Prime Minister, M. Lumumba, said he thought the Belgian Ambassador was reporting the situation at the height of the crisis.

One report said the Ambassador had been expelled to protect Belgian lives.

HUNT COVERS TWO PROVINCES

Big drive by police to net oath offenders

Nearly 1,000 square miles of country in the Central and Rift Valley Provinces of Kenya are being searched by a security force of 500 police officers in a drive to net oath-takers and administrators.

The operation, which began yesterday, is being carried out by the Kenya Police and the Kenya Mounted Police.

DENIAL OF DETENTION WITHOUT TRAIL

Mr. Justice Stewart has ruled that the Government cannot detain a citizen without a hearing. 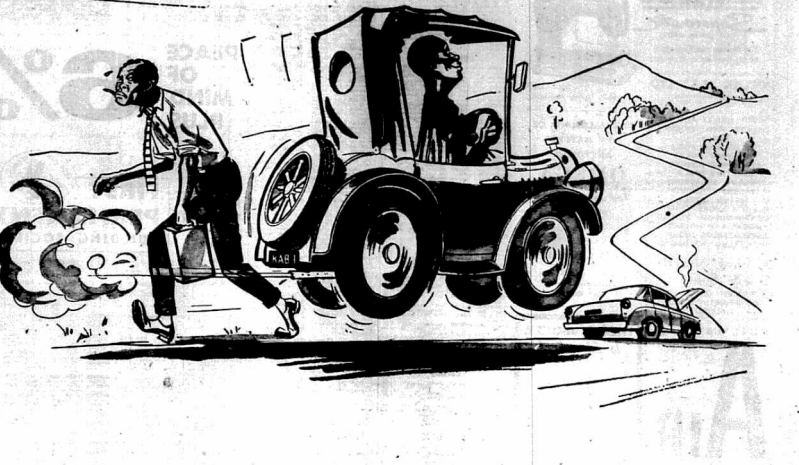

FIGHTING IN NEW COLOR AREAS Belgium sending 500 more reinforcements

WOMAN REFUGEE VOWS TO RETURN

CHAMATIC conditions again prevailed in the Congo Republic as fighting flared in new areas and Belgium announced the dispatch of 500 more troops.

Fresh fighting was reported to have broken out between mutineers at Shinkolobwe, a uranium mining center, 100 miles north-west of Elisabethville.

According to a message picked up by an Elisabethville amateur, the situation at Shinkolobwe was worsening and an appeal had been made for Belgian paratroopers. But when an aircraft attempted to land three minutes from it.

Missionaries surrounded

At another township, 300 miles north-west of Stanleyville, 60 to 70 Europeans were reported to be in a bad spot and expecting shooting—and they were also running out of food. Sixty American missionaries and their families also reported they were surrounded by mutineers at their mission station in the north of Katanga Province. There is nothing to do but wait for their message end.

Some reports from Elisabethville yesterday said the town was quiet after a calm night. But refugees who continued to pour into Northern Rhodesia throughout the day said total chaos reigned there and throughout the Katanga area. They spoke of Greek shoppers being hanged from lamp-posts in the Elisabethville streets and of four Belgians who, trying to return after taking their families over the border, were held up by Congolese and had their throats cut.

The Congo Prime Minister, M. Lumumba, said yesterday he had arranged "with astonishment" of the request by the Katanga Provincial Government for troops to be sent from Northern Rhodesia. Soon afterwards M. Lumumba flew to Elisabethville to see for himself what was happening in Katanga Province.

The head of the Katanga Government, Moïse Tshombe, said for the Rhodians troops late on Sunday. His remark was interpreted as a warning that the Federation army is not to be sent to the north because the foreign army is the responsibility of the British Government; the request had to be sent to London.

CHINESE LOSE 200 IN TIBET REVOLT

CHINESE troops have captured Sikkar Dzong, a strategic Tibetan road center 40 miles north of the Nepal border, after four weeks of fierce battle with Tibetan rebels, according to reports reaching Katmandu.

At least 2,000 Tibetan fighters are reported to be in the Everest region of Nepal and the Government is changing steps to look after them.

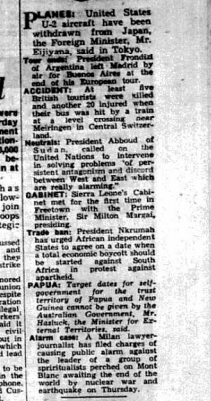

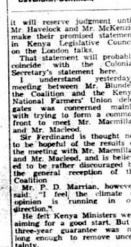

Refugees settle in after hours of uncertainty

Relieved from fear for their lives, Belgian refugees such as those seen on this page walked the streets of Nairobi yesterday, looking at shops and gaining a "second wind" after the first shock of their arrival in two R.A.F. Beverley transport aircraft at Eastleigh on Tuesday night.

Some 180 arrivals were taken first to the temporary reception centre at South Hill, where they were given medical attention and received documents and then sent either to the Technical College of Nairobi or to the home of the first Beverley to arrive.

Some of the 180 refugees were taken to the home of Mrs. M. Lumumba, wife of the Belgian Minister of the Republic, who introduced Communist measures.

Mrs. Jamin, wife of the Belgian Commissioner, said that she and her husband, who arrived with her son and two grandsons, were quiet and the Congolese were quite friendly. Her husband was still at his post but was due to retire soon.

Her son, Thierry, said there was a general panic among Europeans. There were no shops at Eastleigh at present but the grandmothers were friendly.

A Congolese had been appointed as District Commissioner.

"My father is still in the same office telling him what to do," he said.

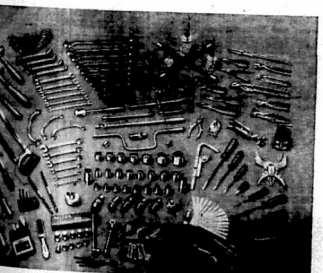
