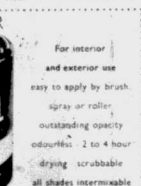

M.P. URGES CLOSER LIAISON

Lesson of Ghana union 'surprise'

SURPRISE caused by the postponement of the proposals for a Ghana-Guinea union indicated that the Commonwealth's consultative machinery needed improving.

Suggesting this in the House of Commons, the former Secretary of State, Mr. J. Roper-Stonham, expressed his surprise that the Government should take such a long time to consider the proposals. He said that the Prime Minister had said that he would be glad to consider the proposals for a consultation between the two countries equal to any development.

Kept informed

The Prime Minister did say on November 21 that he was surprised the Government had not yet taken any steps to improve the machinery. However, he received a full report from Mr. Roper-Stonham and it does not, I think, reflect upon the Government's machinery.

The Minister kept an informant of the actual situation at the time. The Ghana-Guinea union was certainly before the Commonwealth committee at that year's conference, the Home Secretary added.

NATO INSISTS ON SETTLEMENT OF GERMAN PROBLEM

Answer to Russian threat over Berlin DEFENCE REVIEW

An equitable settlement of the German question, linked with European security arrangements, and an agreement on controlled disarmament were listed as essential in the interests of peace in a communique issued at the end of the Ministerial Council talks in Paris.

The Atlantic Pact Ministers, who ended a three-day session in Paris on Thursday, declared their resolution not to yield to any threat over Berlin, and expressed the hope that negotiations for a multilateral economic agreement in Europe would be successful.

They stated that the Soviet Union had ignored Western proposals to bring about a settlement of the long-running East-West, and that the Ministers had decided to continue the search for a solution to the German problem, to obtain without relaxation the effort of the Western countries to improve the defensive power of the Alliance.

The Ministers also expressed their hope that negotiations for a multilateral economic association in Europe would be successful. The Council agreed to hold further meetings which will mark the tenth anniversary of the signing of the North Atlantic Treaty in Washington on April 4.

While the Council discussed the terms of the communique, the Foreign Ministers of Britain, Greece and Turkey held their first tripartite top-level talks for three years at the Cyprus issue. The three Ministers said afterwards that they had held useful talks, while authoritative observers said that, in a full exchange of views, they had agreed to continue discussions through diplomatic channels.

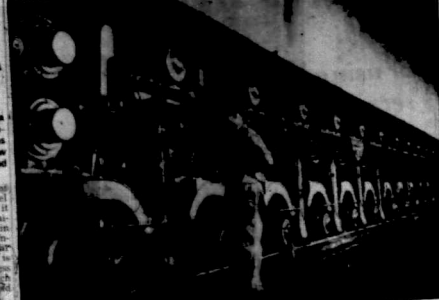



RAILWAY ESTIMATE
THE East African Central Legislative Assembly approved the setting in motion of a Bill when it was addressed by the Financial Secretary of the High Commission, Mr. H. H. Hinchey, the Commissioner for Transport, Maj. Gen. W. H. D. Williams, and the Postmaster-General, Mr. H. G. Ellis.

Mr. Hinchey, who moved the adoption of the report of the Select Committee on the Income Tax (Management) Bill, said equality in the treatment of individual taxpayers in like income cases had been the general test of equity which had guided the committee.

A high level of agreement had been reached on the course to be followed in the public interest, and the committee appreciated all the trouble and care which had been made constructive, especially the advice of representative bodies.

High-rated traffic erosion
Increased postal charges, for surface mail to Commonwealth countries were announced by the Postmaster-General when he introduced his estimate for next year. Mr. Ellis said the revised rates, which should come into force on April 1, would be the minimum allowed by the General Postal Union Convention. These would be 10s for a 100 letter compared with 8s 6d previously. The new rates would not apply to members of the African Postal Union, such as the Belgian Congo (The Congo) and the Congo Free State.

Regarding the loss of traffic to the roads as a result of the increased rates, Mr. Hinchey said that the railways continued, day after day, to lose traffic to the territories westward of the railway draft estimates of revenue and expenditure for 1959 and 1960 (freeway) and separate estimates of expenditure on capital development and renewals works, 1959.

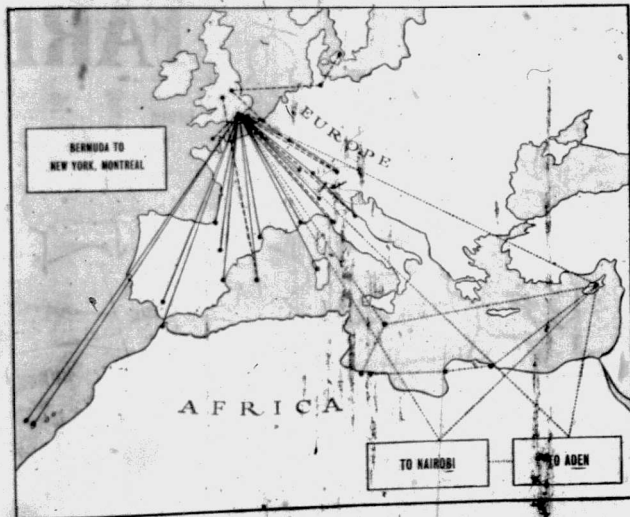

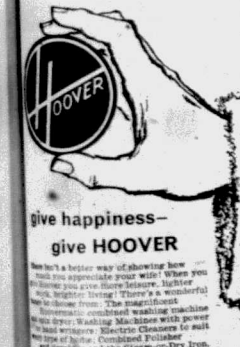
