FRENCH VOTERS SUPPORT OF DE GAULLE Landslide victory in new Assembly

COMMUNISTS ROUSED
GEN. DE GAULLE was yesterday... master of France, after an overwhelming victory in the elections for the National Assembly of the Fifth Republic. His most fervent supporters are extremists who returned as a complete majority in the new Assembly. It has thus fallen from the largest to the smallest party, although its share in the total vote is still the third highest.

Khalil approved coup

Reaction to Greek self-rule demand VIOLENCE DEPLORED

GREK demanded in the United Nations Political Committee that independence for Cyprus should be endorsed. The British warned that such action could only lead to civil war or worse.
