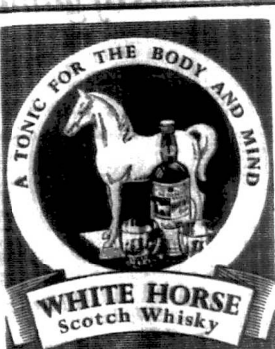

BRITAIN REACHES HALFWAY POINT TO HER 1948 EXPORTS TARGET

French accept coal shipment as first real recovery sign

TWO ENCOURAGING pointers to better days in Britain and Europe at the weekend were an announcement by the President of the British Board of Trade, Mr. Harold Wilson, and the welcome given to the first shipment of coal by French France from the other side of the Channel since the fuel crisis of early last year.

News announced by Mr. Wilson said that provisional export figures for December showed Britain had achieved the highest daily rate of any month since the war—and 'pretty well the highest for a quarter of a century.'

December's exports were nearly 20 per cent higher than in 1947—which means that Britain is halfway towards the 40 per cent increase that has been set as the target for 1948, said Mr. Wilson.

'Still a big gap', says Mr. Wilson

'This is a considerable achievement—in spite of enormous difficulties our exports drive has made sound progress. The whole British people is now backing the drive.'

'But what we all have to remember is that imports have increased greatly and in spite of our achievements we end 1947 with a gap of £200 millions between the value of our exports and the value of our imports.'

French newspapers acclaimed the arrival of British coal as a vital part of their recovery drive. They are going to play a role in the recovery of all Europe—and added 'The French people are delighted to see the arrival of the coal means that dollars can be saved to buy other imports.'

Surprise wheat surplus

A NEW MOVE TO DECLARE TSAVO A NATIONAL PARK

Legislative council asked to take the first step

THEYAS main forest national park, almost as big as the famous Kruger park—may come into being this week. Kenya Legislative Council will be asked by the Member for Agriculture and Natural Resources (Major F. C. Cavalotto-Bentley) to approve of the Governor's declaring the Tsavo game to be the new National Park for the purpose of the National Parks Ordinance.

If the motion is approved by Legislative Council it will constitute the first step towards the means to preserve Kenya's natural assets as the Tsavo park is considered generally to be of great importance than the Nairobi National Park.

Questions were asked in Council comparatively recently as to when the Tsavo national park—100 miles from Mombasa on the way to Nairobi—should be declared and Government promised that an early decision would be made.

7,000 square miles of it
The proposed national park, detailed boundaries of which appear in the Tsavo Today paper, covers approximately 7,000 square miles. It is somewhat less than the area originally proposed by the Game Parks Committee but certain sections have been discarded because of the possibility of their being required for African settlement or re-settlement in the future.

It has many attractions to tourists, its northern end may be considered as an elephant sanctuary, its southern as an area of great beauty.

Specifically excluded from the Tsavo national park are the 100 foot wide main road and railway reserves running through the park and any railway zone for other railway reserves.

Council will also be asked by the Member for Agriculture to ask the Governor to request the Government to acquire land for a national park.

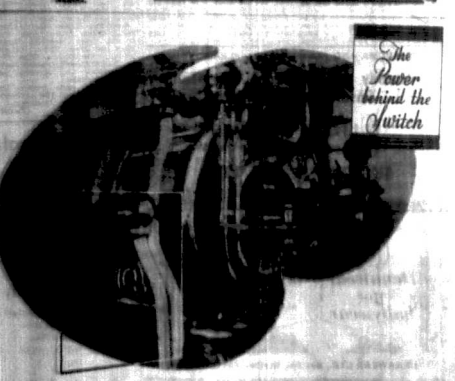

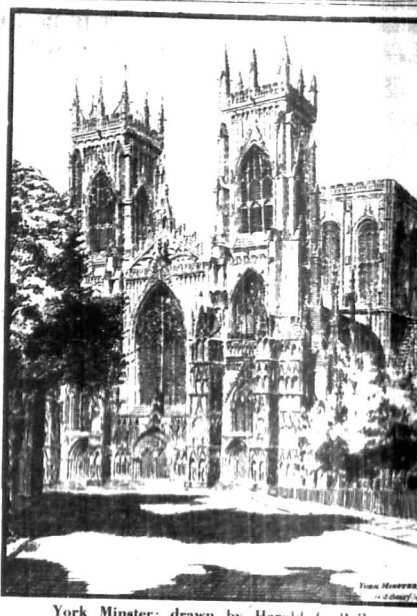

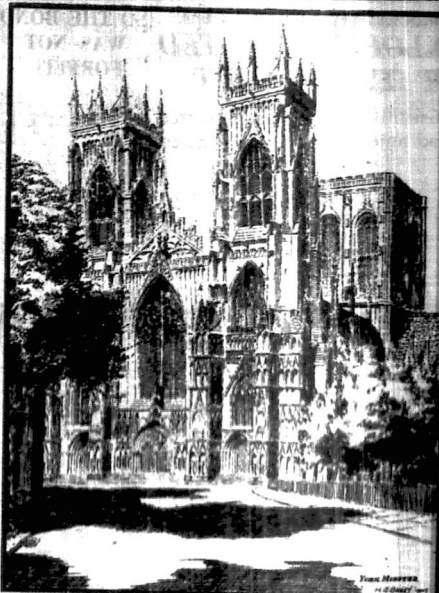
